



Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	<b>833,438</b>

## Highlights

- On 28 August, AFAD, the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Turkey's Government, announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in the 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 219,716. AFAD reported that from 28 to 29 August, a total of 697 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 375 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- Provincial officials in Mardin informed UNHCR that they were instructed by AFAD Ankara that there will be no more referrals of the non-camp Syrians to camps. The provincial officials report having also been instructed to carefully screen the referrals done by police before they were sent to Nusaybin.
- UNHCR teams from Gaziantep and Ankara conducted workshops in Hatay for STL and IRC staff working with refugees. A total of 24 persons took part in the workshops. The workshop was one of the several planned this year to build capacity in the NGO community.
- In Adiyaman, camp officials informed that during the previous week they have admitted and registered eight families (around 60 persons) who have been temporarily accommodated in the waiting area. Camp officials reported that they have around 110 Syrians in the waiting for admission.
- In Altinozu town in Hatay, local officials informed UNHCR that the number of registered non-camp Syrians is 10,149 persons. A UNHCR team visited a school which is reportedly supported by a Turkish NGO and the Syrian Turcoman Association. The teachers in the school informed the team that the NGO provided desks and chairs, but they are still in need of supplies.
