


Highlights

- On 31 August, AFAD, the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Turkey's Government, announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in the 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 220,439. AFAD reported that from 29-31 August, a total of 1,463 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 735 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- DRC informed that they are planning to organize art activities in the central park of Antakya and contacted several other NGOs if they wish to join and support the activity. The activity is planned to take place during September and will be joined by the Syrians attending their community center. In addition, DRC is also planning to distribute about 4,000 kits called "dignity kits" that include clothes and toiletries for women.
- In Viransehir camp, officials informed that the number of non-camp Syrians transferred to Viransehir camp passed 2,700 persons during the last 2-3 weeks of Aug. 2014. Camp officials informed that majority of these transfers were Syrians from Gaziantep while some were also transferred from other provinces. Camp officials informed that around 500 of these new arrivals still need to be registered which will bring the total camp population over 14,000.
- In Adana Saricam camp, officials informed that are more than 40 people temporarily accommodated in the waiting area. Camp officials stated that they have started to admit those who were previously registered in the camp but did not report back after their leave and who have family members in the camp. The others will have to wait until space becomes available.
- Adana camp officials informed that while they were trying their best to admit the Syrians living in the waiting area, another 15-20 Syrians approached the gate and claimed to be new-arrivals.
- In Viransehir, the camp management informed UNHCR that Saudi NGO representatives visited the camp and provided financial assistance to the imams in the camp.
