Summary of discussions and action points

1.	<p>Registration Update by Philip Kibui- Associate Registration Officer-UNHCR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Total registered as of 4th September 2014: 1,182,919 with 21 days waiting period ▪ Overview of Syrian/Iraqi registration trends ▪ A request was made concerning trends on Iraqis appointment ▪ Verification on border crossers: Lebanese state committed to the principle of Non- refoulement Because of increasing number of Syrians crossing Lebanon, GSO to implement entry restrictions ▪ 31 Aug 2014 GSO: Syrian refugees residing in Lebanon illegally can legalize their status or return to Syria without paying penalty fees - there will be a ban on Syrian refugees to reenter Lebanon for a period of 6 month-MoI to send SMS to refugees informing them that they may encounter a ban. ▪ GOL need to tighten the border, MoI to elaborate criteria to ensure that access is provided to PoC who are in need for international protection.
2.	<p>Stabilization : Disaster Risk Management to build Resilience in Food Security</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Strategic objectives: Help eliminate hunger, food insecurity and malnutrition- Make agriculture, forestry and fisheries more productive and sustainable- Reduce rural poverty. Enable inclusive and efficient agricultural and food systems- Increase the resilience of livelihoods to threats and crises. ▪ FAO's integrated approach to disaster risk management (DRM) includes three main elements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Disaster Risk Reduction (prevention, mitigation and preparedness) ○ Response and rehabilitation ○ Transition and linkages to development ▪ FAO defines resilience as: "The ability to prevent disasters and crises as well as to anticipate, absorb, accommodate or recover and adapt from them in a timely, efficient and sustainable manner.
3.	<p>Presentation on Collective Site Management and Coordination</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ CMC - Perception of several acronyms to come up with a standard name –reservation to use words as camps ▪ Needs to Strengthen refugee community structures and Monitor of protection and assistance needs and standards ▪ Development of common reference and general guidelines ▪ Identification of CSMC focal points



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Development of CSMC national action plan eg. Tripoli action plan a model under review to be shared with stakeholders ▪ Partners – NRC, DRC, local NGOs, PU-AMI, Concern, UNHCR, MoSA, Local authority/Municipality ▪ Continuation of Capacity building & mentorship ▪ Need for capacity building for all service providers and Implementation of community- based approach ▪ Clear strategy is needed, an appeal was made to put CSMC under a particular sector in order to better coordinate fundraise and maintain the current sector ▪ Difficulty of acceptance in Lebanese community was noted; need to manage and organize collective sites and shelters and to link it with development and social cohesion fueled by job creation mechanism.
4.	Mass Information: Mapping/INQAL/refugee website update
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ UNHCR finalized an IA draft mapping of available Humanitarian Hotlines and Mass Information Activities in Lebanon with a specific form into the online platform PRISM ▪ As these are related to the INQAL-ongoing view, update and editing directly from the involved organizations is needed ▪ Appeal was made to have focal point contacts to the present agencies. ▪ These focal points would receive an email with a link to give them the opportunity to directly insert/edit the information into PRISM. ▪ Soon a webpage will be launched for refugees this must be shared with focal points.
