



Total Number of Refugees Registered and with Registration Appointments	844,162

Highlights

- On 08 September, AFAD, the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Turkey's Government, announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in the 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 220,777. AFAD reported that from 07 to 08 September, a total of 828 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 445 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Adana Saricam, camp officials informed UNHCR there are around 51 Syrians waiting at the gate, expecting to be admitted into the camp. Camp officials are checking the names of those waiting against the camp records and giving priority to those they are able to confirm they are former camp residents and those who have immediate family members inside the camp. UNHCR team suggested to the camp management using Viransehir camp as an alternative for those who have no relatives inside.
- Officials in Adiyaman camp also informed UNHCR that, as of last weekend, there are around 135 Syrians in the waiting area inside the camp. Reportedly, the camp management admitted and registered 35 of those in the camp.
- Early in the week, media reported that several hundred Syrians entered Turkey through unofficial crossing points and have been living in the streets and fields of Elbeyli town. A UNHCR team visited the town of Elbeyli and was able to observe that several hundred Syrians arrived during the last few weeks. According to the local officials there has not been an influx in big groups, but Syrians arriving individually or in families. They have been waiting for transportation to travel to other cities. A UNHCR team spoke to some of these new arrivals who stated their intentions of looking for a place to live and to find work and moving to other locations if necessary to find it.
- In Harran, camp officials informed UNHCR that they have received dry food packages from a national NGO and they have distributed it to 588 families living in Harran urban and to 100 families of the orphans identified in the camp.
