



Highlights

- On 10 September, AFAD, the Disaster and Emergency Management Agency of Turkey's Government, announced that the total number of Syrians registered and assisted in the 22 camps located in 10 provinces was 220,080. AFAD reported that from 09 to 10 September, a total of 577 Syrians were admitted and registered in the camps and 840 Syrians have voluntarily returned to Syria.
- In Adiyaman, camp officials informed UNHCR that the number of Syrians in the waiting area has reached around 160 individuals expecting to be accommodated in the camp. In Adiyaman urban, officials informed UNHCR that the number of registered non-camp Syrians is over 2,300 individuals. The foreigners' police was assigned to conduct house visits to non-camp Syrians families in order to identify children of school age and inform their families about the opportunity to send their children to school in the camp, They are informing the families that the children's transportation will be covered by the government. The camp school manager expects around 100 non-camp Syrians children to attend the school in Adiyaman camp.
- UNHCR field team was informed by the local administrator (muhtar) of Bohsin village of Altinozu town (near Boynuyogun camp) of Hatay province, that there are 246 families registered and living in Bohsin village. The muhtar stated that, due to increased security measures along the border, the trend of arrivals and returns between Turkey and Syria has noticeably decreased. The muhtar also stated that he is supporting vulnerable families in the village with donations and helping them to find odd jobs.
- In Viranşehir camp, officials informed UNHCR that during the weekend they have received about 300 Syrians who were reportedly sent from Ankara as per AFAD Ankara's instruction. The group, which will increase the camp population to almost 15,000, was admitted and are being registered. They were also given hot meals as they were being admitted and later they were provided with cooking utilities to prepare their own food.
