



## SGBV Field Sub-Working Group – Za’atari Thursday, January 29, 2015 – UNHCR Meeting Room 2 – Meeting Minutes

**Chair:** IRC

**Attendants:** UNFPA, UNHCR, UN-women, IRD, OXFAM, Save the Children, NRC, WFP, UNICEF, Foundation FPSC, Handicap International.

- **2015 Priorities – Brainstorming discussions:** Building on the 2014 ToR, trends in GBV-IMS and safety audit findings, the group discussed 2015 working group priorities. These include:
  - a) Improve access for GBV survivors and others at-risk to multi-sectorial, comprehensive services,
  - b) Prioritise SGBV mainstreaming across different sectors and functions and enhance advocacy efforts including engagements with the government, health and legal actors;
  - c) Explore opportunities for men and improved service procedures to prevent and mitigate conflict and domestic violence and release psychosocial stress;
  - d) Promote long term service sustainability and improved provision of quality and timely ad-hoc services by building the capacity of staff, particularly the Syrian refugees in provision of psychosocial support, First-Aid, PSE, and minimum protection, SGBV and CP standards.

**Target groups** = GBV survivors and others at risk (this include persons with disabilities, women and girls who live in isolation, adolescent girls, single women and girls and newly arrived women and girls – particularly from urban to camps).

**Approaches** = Survivor-centered, Gender and Protection Sensitive, Child Best Interest, AGDM (special efforts especially for persons with disabilities), multi-sectorial – coordinated, community-based.

**Sharing practices, experiences and lessons-learnt** = promote best practices through sharing knowledge and experience with other Jordan based setting including Azraq and Urban.

**Action Point** = use points to further develop 2015 ToR, detailing methodologies, work-plans and monitoring tools.

- **SGBV Sub-Working Group – Handover discussion / new Za’atari SGBV WG Coordinator election:** Following IRC’s handover of activities in Za’atari, including SGBV working group coordination functions, special emphasis needs to be put in place for the election of a new chair.
