This map indicates:

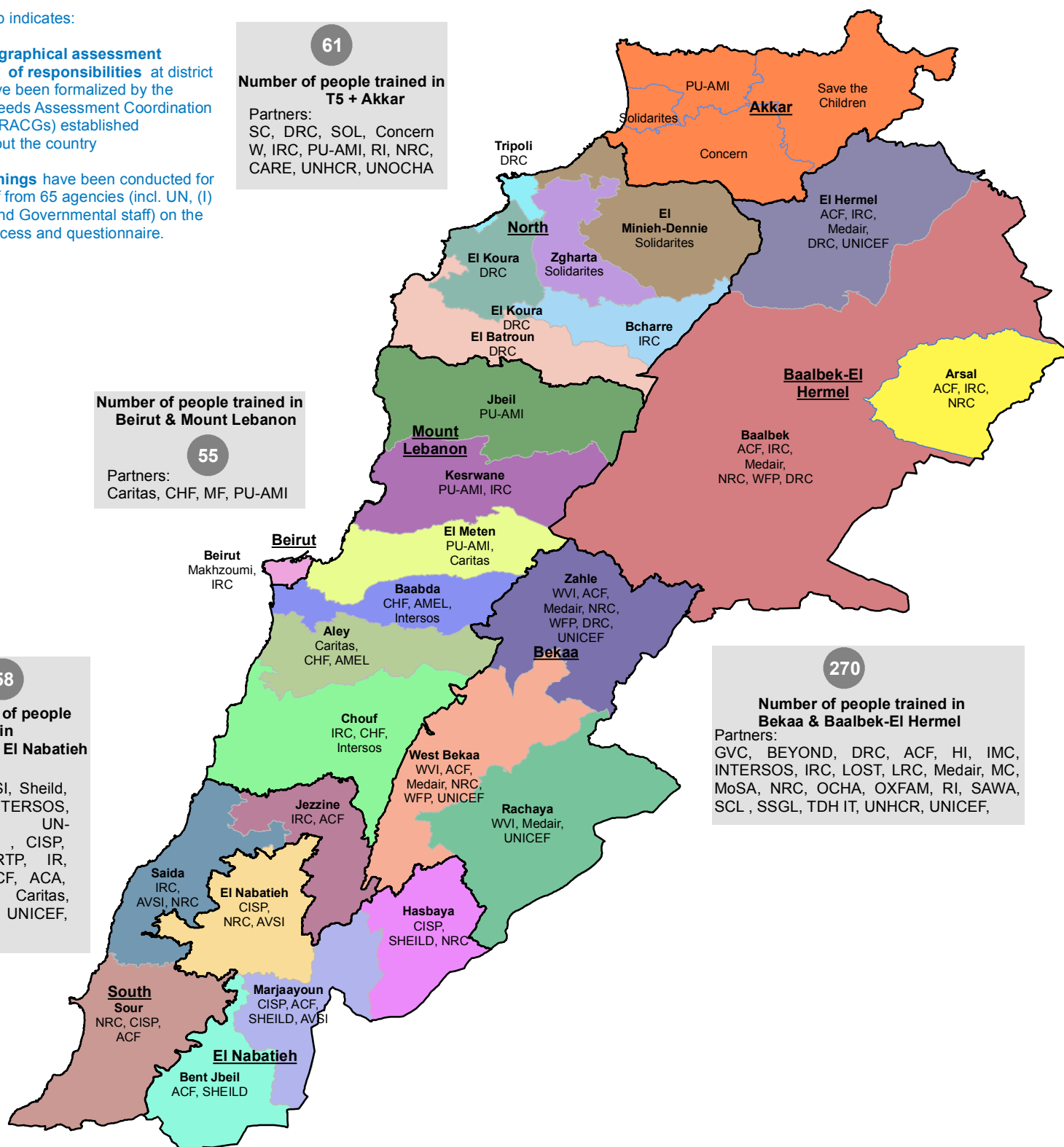
- Geographical assessment division of responsibilities** at district level have been formalized by the Rapid Needs Assessment Coordination groups (RACGs) established throughout the country
