HIGHLIGHTS


As a part of the collaboration between the Ministry of Education and Higher Education (MEHE) and UNICEF during the 2015-2016 winter, a total of 1,221,000 liters of fuel were successfully provided through MEDCO for the heating and lighting of classrooms in 564* Lebanese public schools located in high altitude areas (more than 500 m above sea level), targeting approximately 165,000 children in first and second shift schools. The first round of distribution was completed by the 15th of December 2015 and the second round by the 4th of March 2016.

*Originally it was planned to serve 586 schools, but 22 schools used a different fuel (Liquid Gas Petroleum) or had their premises closed. 34 schools in the highest altitude received a top-up instead.




Quantity Distributed per Round (Liters)




Schools Served per Governorate
