Zaatari Strategic Plan 2017-2020 Discussion for WASH sector

- Updated WASH plan has been shared to the WG along with the matrix.
- WASH Strategic Plan covered five objectives followed by set of activities, These objectives are:
 - (1) Syrian Refugees residing in Zaatari Camp have equitable access to adequate and safe water supply in accordance with agreed minimum quantity standards and national quality standards.
 - (2) Ensure adequate access to and use of improved sanitation facilities, and human excreta is adequately and hygienically managed in the camp, including schools and other institutions.
 - (3) Storm water is effectively managed to ensure proper drainage.
 - (4) Ensure effective, environmentally friendly solid waste management.
 - (5) Support refugees to identify, adopt and practice key hygiene and resources conservation behaviours for improved public health and environmental sustainability.
- Agreed not to have a specific workshop to finalise the plan.
- Jill (UNHCR) is the focal point to review the plan along with the matrix and will make sure the following:
 - Narrative consistency.
 - Technical, operational and community based plan.
 - Spelling and grammar check.
- Additional points need to be included at the plan:
 - WASH related diseases activities.
 - Technical, operational and community based.
 - Cost effective.
 - Community driven.
- Constructive feedback to be sent to Jill (UNHCR) COB on Thursday 26 May.
- Abrassac (UNICEF) will share the final plan with the WG on Monday 30 May.
- Final submission on Sunday 5 June (next meeting).
- Camp management presentation on Tuesday 7 June.

Last week, UNICEF and UNHCR discussed the toilets replacement; they came up with a decision that for the existing toilets it's not a priority to replace them, unless we get fund.
