Zaatari Wastewater Network

Phase (1):

Through IRD, district 6,8 and 9 shall be covered.

Phase (2):

Through local consultancy firm (ACE), phase (2) of the main sewer network is designed

Vector Control

Rodent Control:

- Throughout the year, two rounds of rodent control is being done; the first in February and the second is on August.
- Each round is consisted of two waves that are two weeks separated, in each wave; the entire camp is covered (including refugees shelters, market areas, NGOs compounds, schools, health facilities,...etc.).
- The single round takes about two months to finish.
- We are currently doing this controlling campaigns in both camps, Al-Zaatari and Azraq refugees camp, and in Rabaa Sarhan center.

Vector Control

Insects Control:

- For this year, Fly control campaign will be taken place by the end of August/staring September.
- The controlling will be done in two ways:
 1. Spraying insecticides inside the dumpsters after cleaning them,
 2. Distributing fly traps with two refills to all the facilities in the camp (NGOs compounds, schools, health facilities)
- We are planning on doing this controlling campaign in both camps, Al-Zaatari and Azraq refugees camp, and in Rabaa Sarhan center.

Kits Distribution

The following kits are being distributed in Zaatari and Azraq refugees camp:

- Hygiene kits:

Each kit contains; soap, dish washing liquid, detergent and washing powder along with 4 JOD voucher. And its being distributed once every 3 months.

- Diapers:

1. Adults diapers: currently we don't have funding for this item.
2. Baby diapers: it's being distributed once every 45 days.

- Female hygiene products: we distribute around 38,000 pack of sanitary napkins for the females between the age of (12 to 45), and it's being distributed once every 45 days.

Storm Water Drainage Network

- Currently we are in the process of designing storm water drainage network to cover Zaatari camp.
- Once we have funding, the implementation of the network shall start.

Host Communities

For the past three years, UNHCR focused on urgent rehabilitation of water infrastructure to improve water supply in target communities in northern Jordan in close coordination with Ministry of Water and Irrigation. Also focused on rehabilitation of wastewater collection infrastructure and expansion of wastewater treatment plant capacities.

Host Communities – WASH projects

1. Rehabilitation for many wells in Mafraq, Ajloun and Irbid
2. Maintenance for filtration stations in Ramtha
3. Rehabilitation for Naderah water network
4. Rehabilitation of Akaidier waste water treatment plant (reception facility for Zaatari refugee camp wastewater)
5. Rehabilitation for Ramtha transmission line
6. Implementation/construction Moghair-Irbid transmission pipeline
7. Fittings replacement for Irbid water network
