

Total Arrivals in 2016 (as of 29 Feb, 2016) - Greece: **124,481** Italy: **9,100**

Top 8 nationalities of Mediterranean Sea arrivals: Afghanistan, Eritrea, Iraq, Iran, Nigeria, Pakistan, Somalia, Syria.

Figure 2. Total arrivals to each country by nationality





Figure 3. Top nationalities of arrivals in Greece, Italy and Spain

Figure 4. Percentages of nationalities arriving to Greece




Figure 5. Greece: Trend of Monthly sea arrivals by nationality





Figure 6. Greece: Percentage of top nationalities of Mediterranean sea arrivals by month

This graph includes the top nationalities of Mediterranean sea arrivals and the top 5 other nationalities of sea arrivals to Italy.




Figure 8. Italy: Trend of Top nationalities of Mediterranean sea arrivals




Figure 9. Italy: Percentage of top nationalities of Mediterranean sea arrivals by month





Figure 10. Italy: Trend of Monthly sea arrivals of other nationalities



SPAIN

Figure 11. Percentages of nationalities arriving to Spain




Figure 12. Spain: Trend of the Top nationalities of Mediterranean sea arrivals





Figure 13. Spain: Percentages of top nationalities of Mediterranean Sea arrivals
