

CHIOS NFI/Shelter Coordination Meeting - 15 June 2016

Attendees: UNHCR, NRC, SP, Drop in the Ocean, CESRT, Municipality

1) SUMMER SHOE DISTRIBUTION - VIAL

- Drop in the Ocean - Sufficient female shoes (400-500 pairs) available to distribute in Vial
- CESRT - Sufficient children shoes to distribute in Vial and assorted in sizes.
- NRC - To transport 700 men flip flops to Vial storage 3.

Action Point: Actors to set a date to organize shoe distribution in Vial

2) SUMMARIZATION OPTIONS FOR SOUDA AND DIPETHE

- NRC - 300m² shade netting is in place. Intend to make 10 more shade netting (3x3m) for 3 sites. Area to cover: the entrance corridor of Vial and at the back of Dipethe. In addition to shade netting, NRC will look into installing fans inside Dipethe.

Action Point: NRC to update status of shade netting and summarization for Dipethe

- SP - Waiting for the feedback of pilot installation of ACs in the rub hall on Lesvos. Plan to install ACs in 3 rub halls in Souda if successful. SP explored different options of summerising the RHUs – e.g. installation of fans - concerns on electricity capacity and safety.

Action Point: SP to update status on feasibility of AC installation in rub hall

3) PROCUREMENT STATUS

- NRC - Plastic chairs without handle (approx. 3 per container): Vial 500, Souda 400, Dipethe 100, 40 additional chairs, brooms with no stick for Vial - PR in progress, 2,000 plastic cups – no confirmed timeline, no adult diaper.
- SP- 2,500 metal cups – budget approved

4) UNDERWEAR DISTRIBUTION - VIAL

- SP and Drop in the Ocean will collaborate to carry out underwear distribution outside Vial. SP to collect underwear sizes for men and children, Drop in the Ocean will do women fitting outside on the next day.

Action point: SP and Drop in the Ocean to confirm distribution details and carry out size mapping and fitting next week

5) DIVISION OF RESPONSIBILITIES – SHELTER

- SP

- Procuring metal picnic tables for the football pitch (approx. 350 Euro each) for Vial
 - Shading structure for the picnic table area
 - Confirmed electrical work for Souda
 - To procure 71 fire extinguishers for Souda and Dipethe
 - Installation of fire extinguishers holders
 - Replace all broken windows - Vial
 - Installation of privacy curtains – Vial
 - Installation of paper dispenser and soap dispensers – Vial
 - Hygiene kiosk – obtained 2 quotations - Vial
- NRC
- Installation of new charging unit in Souda
 - Electrical work and summarization of Dipethe
 - FRS may allow NRC to do the following WASH/Shelter activities in Vial: toilet repairs, handicap ramps, toilet containers, shelving for storage 3 &5, reverse osmosis system. Pending discussion on pipe protection, AC repairs, hot water system, fire equipment and light bulb replacement. Further discussion with FRS Athens next week.

Action Point: NRC to update confirmed SHELTER/ WASH activities in Vial

6) SOUDA REBUILD

- 7 new container units to arrive in Souda on Friday. There will be a fence structure around the new administrative area. As NGOs relocate to new administrative area, the Child friendly space might be emptied out and available for other activities. Both Drop in the Ocean and CESRT are interested in utilizing the area for clothing distribution.

Action point: Municipality to confirm the space availability

- NRC is looking into putting dividers in the rub hall

Action Point: Municipality to comment on viability

- SP to cover electrical work for Souda rebuild
