


# Relocation Factsheet:Population Information Update

11 December 2016 UNHCR Zimbabwe -Tongogara

**Overview:** This document presents PoC population statistics for indviduals relocated from the buffer zone in Chipinge Discrit to Tongogara Refugee Camp. Population statistics also include PoC who joined the camp spontanuesly during the last 2 days (7 indviduals). All PoC have been biometrically enrolled and registered upon arrival to Tongogara camp. At the date of the production of this Factheet a third convoy is on the way to the camp.


