Agency Update members:	<p>JRP: JRP project summary sheets is still under review by MoPIC, a budget reduction have been requested from the overall Social Protection budget. Reduction have been managed without effecting partner's appeals. The Inter-Agency Appeal. Inter-Agency Coordination Unit and sector coordinators advocacy continue with MoPIC to prevent further reduction on Protection core projects. There is clear agreement amongst all that ensuring services for women, children, and vulnerable families is the priority of the refugee response, an encouraging development..</p> <p>If further reductions is requested, partners might be contacted to reduce their appeals.</p> <p>BERM: Lifesaving assistance distribution is on-going by Contractors by coordination with community leaders. Attempts to distribute through a distribution points, several east from the existing center of the population and former service area. Current planning is to ensure food and NFI distribution on a universal basis as the most immediate need; there is no opening at present for discussion on admissions so far with the Jordanian Government. Medical service area is also in preparation on the Jordan side of the berm; patients will be facilitated access by security forces for treatment, after which they will return to the Syrian side of the berm.</p>
