Utilization of ToT on IASC principles and PFA	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Inter-organization trainings are to be scheduled on PFA and IASC principles.• The need of finding funding for conducting a ToT on PFA for children was discussed.• All the actors present agreed on the need to share all the training activities.
Final discussion on the advocacy letter	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The feedback that was received was agreed to be added in the letter. Babel will share the letter as soon as possible in order to be finalized in the next MHPSS Sub-WG.
The implementation of KEELPNO's new programme	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No further information was published regarding the implementation of this programme.
Discussion on the handover of sensitive information when PoC are moved	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• After the request that the MHPSS Sub-WG has received by the Protection WG the issue of cases handover was discussed. All the actors present agreed on the following principles:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The issue of handover is not only an issue of inter-organization communication but there are certain prerequisites and procedures to which all those who gather and elaborate sensitive personal data need conform with. We refer to the greek legislation and the Hellenic Data Protection Authority on relevant issues. All the actors involved need to be aware of these procedures and follow them. • As far as the professional relationship between the beneficiaries and the professionals is concerned, the professional should ask the permission of his or her client to use the personal information and pass it to others • It is also important all the actors to advocate in order to gain better processes of moving for the refugees. This means that people and professionals should be informed for their move within a reasonable timeframe before it happens. This timeframe is needed in order for both sides to have the time to appropriately manage the “ separation” and prepare the handover.
