

The overarching goal of the education sector is to ensure access to safe, equitable and quality education for children and youth and to strengthen the capacity of education systems to deliver an effective, coordinated and evidence-based education response.

Key strategic shifts that relate to the education policy environment, access and quality of education are taking place in the five host countries to effectively address the education challenges resulting from the Syria crisis.

In terms of access, learning spaces will be expanded and maximized including through the formalization of second shifts and investments in new technologies. Access strategies will also include enhanced focus on learning at the post-basic level and a more systematic targeting of youth aged 15-17.

In relation to quality education, life skills and citizenship education will be promoted as an integral part of formal and non-formal provision for all age groups and grades. At the system level, the policy development, planning and sector coordination capacity of education systems will continue to be strengthened at both national and sub-national levels.




