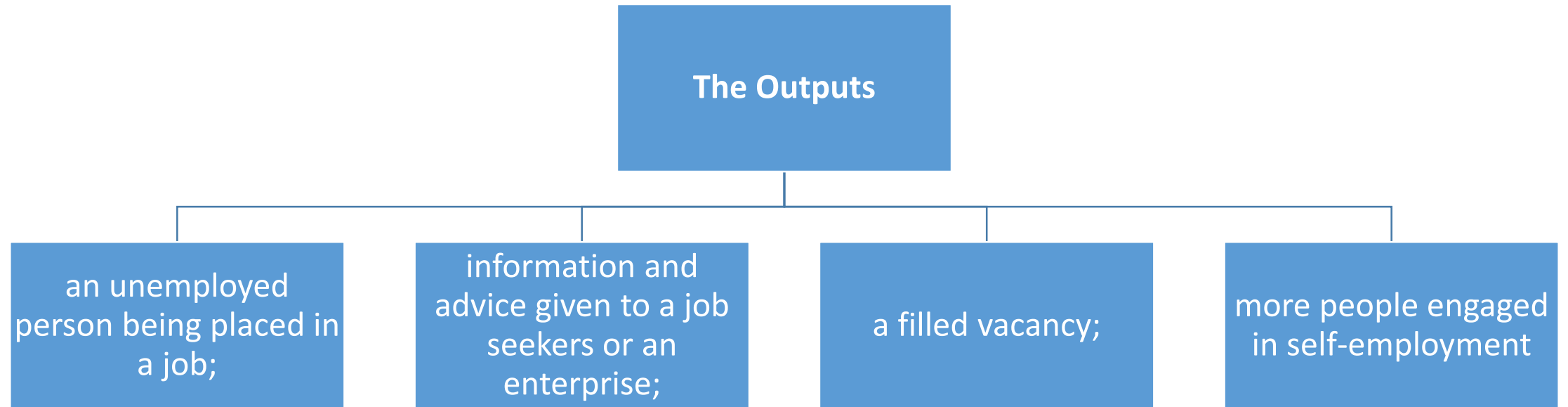

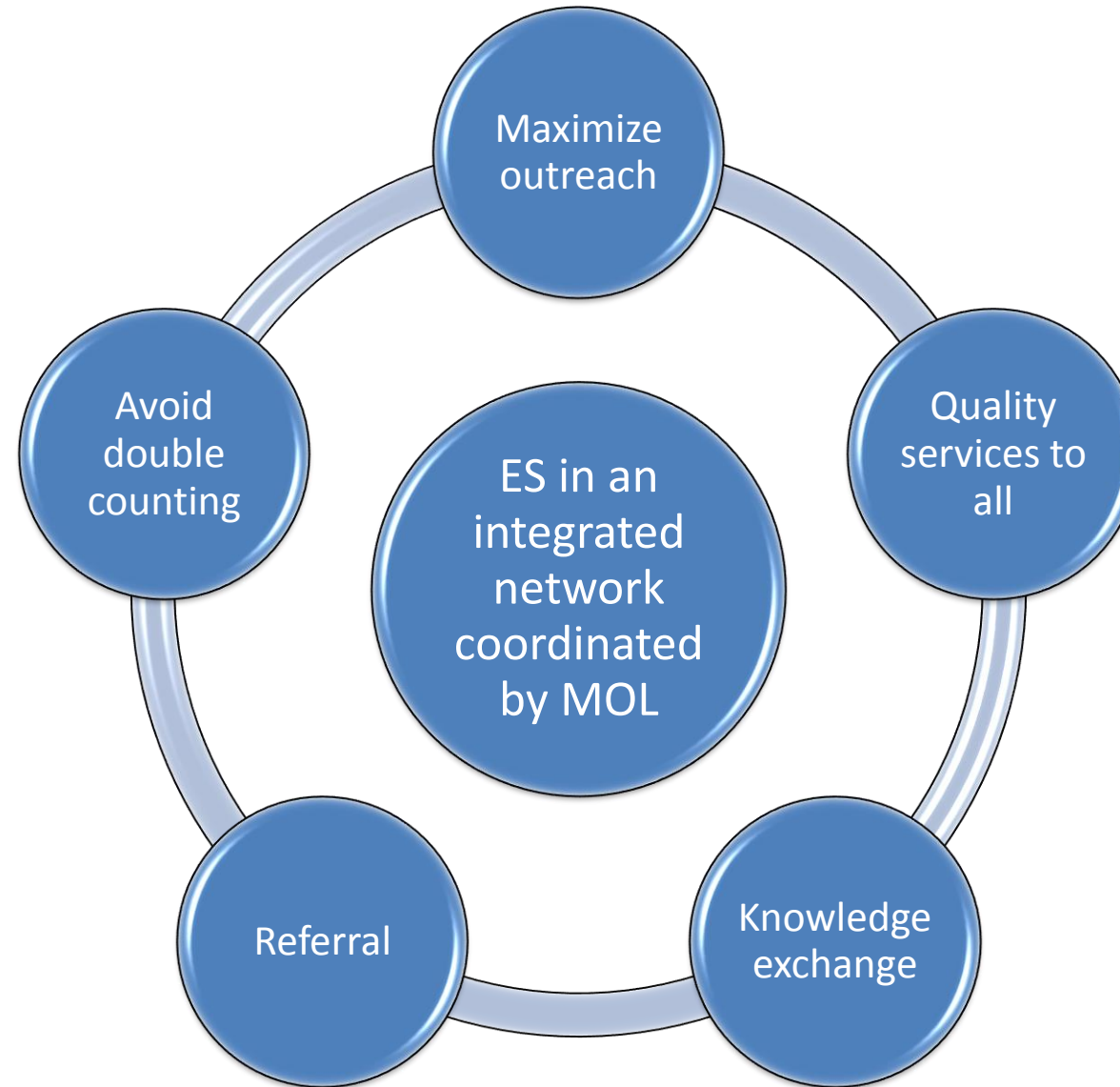

EMPLOYMENT SERVICES UNDER THE LABOUR CODE

Article 10

(1) The Ministry shall be in charge of the organization of the labour market and of careers counselling , and shall draw up the necessary guidelines for the promotion of jobs and recruitment opportunities for Jordanians within the Kingdom and abroad, in cooperation with the appropriate bodies.

(2) Private employment offices may be established upon authorization by the Minister. Their conditions of establishment, objectives, functions and methods of management, as well as their supervision by the Ministry shall be set out in regulations that shall be issued for that purpose.

(3) The minister can allow Associations, syndicates, professional associations, universities, municipalities, chamber of industries and commerce or any public bodies to be the intermediaries to facilitate the employment of the Jordanians without fees.

Article 11

Public and authorized private employment offices shall be the sole intermediaries empowered to recruit or facilitate the recruitment of workers within the Kingdom or abroad. The Minister may close down offices violating the provisions of this section and bring judicial proceedings against them. Convicted violators shall be fined no less than two hundred and no more than one thousand Dinars and/or shall be sentenced to a minimum of thirty days in prison; offices found to be acting in violation of the provisions of this section shall be closed down, and all their assets relating to employment activities shall be confiscated.

التشغيل والتوجيه المهني

المادة 10-

أ- تتولى الوزارة ، بالتنسيق والتعاون مع الجهات المختصة ، مهام تنظيم سوق العمل والتوجيه المهني وتوفير فرص العمل والتشغيل للاردنيين داخل المملكة وخارجها ولهذه الغاية يجوز لها انشاء مكاتب لتشغيل الاردنيين او الترخيص بانشاء مكاتب خاصة لهذه الغاية 0

ب- مع مراعاة احكام أي تشريع آخر ، يجوز للوزير الترخيص بانشاء مكاتب خاصة لتنظيم استخدام واستقدام العمال غير الاردنيين في القطاعات التالية :-

1- قطاع العاملين في المنازل وبستانييها وطهايتها ومن في حكمهم 0

2- أي قطاع آخر يوافق عليه مجلس الوزراء وبما لا يتعارض مع اهداف الوزارة وسياستها في توفير فرص العمل و تشغيل الأردنيين 0

ج- تحدد احكام وشروط انشاء المكاتب الخاصة المشار اليها في الفقرتين (أ) و(ب) من هذه المادة بما في ذلك اسس وشروط تجديد ترخيص هذه المكاتب سنوياً وحالات الغاء الترخيص وكيفية ادارتها واشراف الوزارة عليها وتحديد بدل الخدمات التي تقدمها هذه المكاتب بمقتضى انظمة تصدر لهذه الغاية.

د- للوزير السماح للنقابات ونقابات اصحاب العمل والنقابات المهنية والجامعات والبلديات والغرف الصناعية والتجارية واي هيئات عامة اخرى للقيام باعمال الوساطة لتشغيل الأردنيين شريطة عدم تقاضي أي بدل مقابل ذلك 0

المادة (11)

مع مراعاة احكام الفقرة (د) من المادة (10) من هذا القانون لا يجوز لغير مديريات التشغيل العامة ومكاتب التشغيل الخاصة المرخصة القيام بأعمال الوساطة لتشغيل أو تسهيل تشغيل العمال في داخل المملكة وخارجها ، وللوزير إغلاق المحل المخالف لأحكام هذه المادة واحالته إلى المحكمة ويعاقب كل من يخالف أحكام هذه المادة بغرامة لا تقل عن مئتي دينار ولا تزيد على ألف دينار أو بالحبس لمدة لا تقل عن ثلاثين يوماً ولا تزيد على ستة اشهر أو بكليتا العقوبتين وإفقال أي محل يستعمل لهذه الغاية ومصادرة موجوداته المتعلقة بغرض التشغيل.

How it will work?



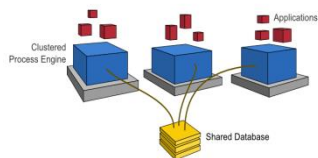
Fully Integrated Online System

Super Counselling System

Management Functions

- Integration of counseling centers
- Coordination of management activities
- Coordination of HR activities
- Coordination of Administration, purchasing, logistics, etc.
- Coordination of Administration, purchasing, logistics, etc.
- Coordination of meetings, appoints, and schedules of events

Online Counselling Functions

- Online assessment test
- Building a resume online
- Online courses for skills development
- Job search and online job matching facility
- Job seekers database management
- Online Training courses

Awareness and communication
