



ETT Report: No. 23

Reporting period: 11 July–17 July 2017

Bama, Chibok, Damboa, Dikwa, Gubio, Gwoza, Jere, Kaga, Kala Balge, Konduga, Kukawa, Kwaya Kusar, Mafa, Monguno and Ngala



Location Movement

- STATE: Borno
LGA: Bama** A total of 177 individuals (INDs) arrived at Bama and 2 INDs departed from Bama for Lassa in Askira Uba LGA, Adamawa State during the reporting period. 84 INDs arrived at General Hospital Camp Bama after fleeing from insurgent attacks in Abbaram ward of Bama LGA (urgent needs are food, NIF and shelter), 39 INDs arrived at Banki town from Kolofata in Cameroon, 46 INDs arrived at Banki town from Kumshe ward in Bama, 5 INDs arrived at Banki camp from Mokolo in Cameroon and 3 INDs arrived at General Hospital Camp from Konduga LGA.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Chibok** 35 INDs arrived at Chibok during the reporting period. 14 INDs arrived from Shehuri North in Maiduguri M.C, 14 INDs arrived from Damboa LGA and 7 INDs arrived from Askira Uba LGA in Adamawa State.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Damboa** 23 INDs arrived at Damboa during the reporting period. 9 INDs arrived at Shuwari community from Ajari central ward in Damboa, 7 INDs arrived at Ajari community from Azur Multe village in Damboa and 7 INDs arrived at General Hospital Camp Damboa from Kafa/Mafi ward of Damboa LGA.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Dikwa** 88 INDs arrived at Dikwa during the reporting period. 31, 27 and 23 individuals respectively arrived at Dikwa 20–Housing Unit Camp from Boboshe, Gulumba and Muliye wards in Dikwa. Medical assistance and food support are been provided by humanitarian partners on the ground.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Gubio** 3 INDs arrived at Gubio Wango from Baram Kura, Artimini Ward of Gubio LGA due to poor living conditions in Artimini ward.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Gwoza** 342 INDs arrived at Gwoza during the reporting period. 296 IND returned to Gwoza from Jere LGA due to poor living conditions and their lack of access to livelihood activities such as farming while in Jere, 37 INDs arrived at Pulka Transit Camp from neighbouring wards in Gwoza and 9 INDs arrived at Gwoza town from nearby communities.

Location Movement

- STATE: Borno
LGA: Jere** 1,389 INDs arrived at Custom House Camp in Jere from Shuwari village in Mafa LGA. They were brought in by SEMA and are currently constructing shelters using tarpaulins received from humanitarian partners at Shuwari. 46 INDs left Fori Camp in Jere to Bulabulin in Gwoza.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Kaga** 10 INDs arrived at Low–Cost–Camp 2 in Benisheikh from Konduga LGA and 1 IND arrived at Aisha Buhari Camp from Maiduguri M.C. LGA. 9 INDs left Lawanti in Benisheikh for Potiskum in Yobe State.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Kala Balge** 106 INDs arrived at Kala Balge during the reporting period. 92 INDs arrived from Duksuri ward in Dikwa LGA and 14 INDs arrived from Sigal ward of Kala Balge.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Konduga** 8 INDs arrived at Boarding Primary School Camp Konduga from Kuwari ward of Konduga LGA due to poor living conditions at Kuwari.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Kukawa** 110 INDs (89 returnees and 21 IDPs) arrived at Kukawa during the reporting period. 41 INDs returned to Baga from Maiduguri. M.C, 28 INDs returned to Baga from Sokoto State, 20 INDs returned to Baga from Kebbi State, and 21 IDPs arrived from Konduga and Jere LGAs.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Kwaya /Kusar** 199 INDs arrived at Anguwan Kwaya from Buni Yadi ward, Yobe State. They are in need of food, shelter and NFI.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Mafa** 152 INDs (124 returnees and 28 IDPs) arrived at Mafa during the reporting period. 124 INDs returned to Mafa from Jere LGA, 15 IDPs arrived from Ngala and 13 IDPs arrived from Muna IDP Camp in Jere.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Monguno** 35 INDs arrived at Government Senior Science Secondary School Camp Monguno from Kukawa LGA. 24 INDs left Monguno for Kukawa LGA to engage in farming activities.
- STATE: Borno
LGA: Ngala** 523 INDs arrived at Ngala during the reporting period; 446 INDs arrived at International School Camp and 77 arrived at NRC Camp. 208 INDs arrived at International School Camp from Cameroon, 238 INDs arrived at International School Camp from nearby wards in Ngala and 77 INDs arrived at NRC Camp from Fuye ward in Ngala.
