


Cumulative displacements and trends 1 January - July 2017

Map showing regions of origin of displacements (departures) by reason - cumulative year to date




About PRMN

Displacement origins year to date




Displacements age and gender breakdown




Note: disaggregated data for displaced persons are based on those displacement reports where data has been collected at household level.





Cumulative displacements and trends by reason and region 1 January - July 2017







Note 1
PRMN partners record displacements by interviewing displaced households and key informants. The figures shown are based on interviews "on arrival" i.e. at destination. However, in some circumstances, displacements reported "on departure" may be significant - for example, 59,000 displacements due to floods in Belet Weyne in May 2016 are not included in the figures above.
