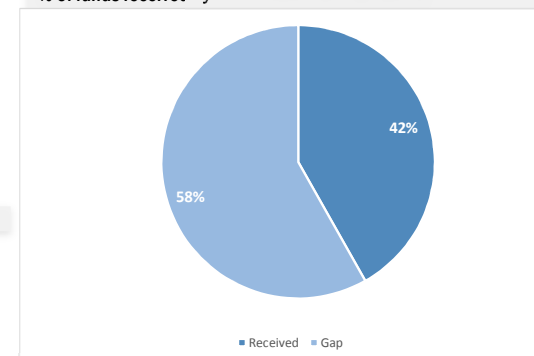

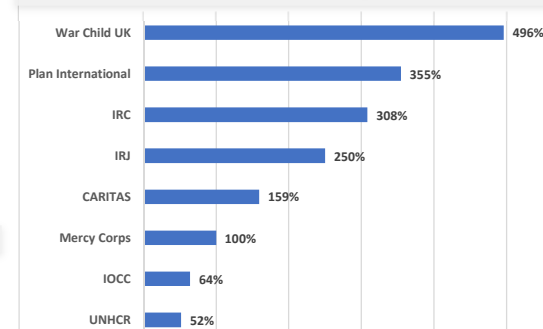
#### % of funds received by Child Protection sub-sector
