Every woman, adolescent and youth everywhere, especially those furthest behind, have fully exercised their reproductive rights and used sexual and reproductive health services free of coercion, discrimination and violence.



Output 1: Enhanced capacities to develop and implement policies, including financial protection mechanisms, that prioritize access to SRHR information and services by those women, adolescents, and youths left furthest behind, including in humanitarian settings



Output 2: Strengthened capacities in delivering quality integrated family planning, comprehensive maternal health and STIs and HIV information and services, in particular for adolescents and youth and in humanitarian settings



Output 3: Strengthened capacities for improving human resources for health management and skills, especially for midwives, to deliver quality and integrated SRH services, including in humanitarian settings
