Shelter UNHCR	<p>UNHCR and CMAs have undertaken with the Government counterpart discussions on shelter repair and maintenance solutions based on the most updated shelter assessment done in Sittwe camps by the Government. The assessments have highlighted the need to implement rapid repair and maintenance prior to rainy season. As discussions are still ongoing, further information will be shared once agreement is made.</p>
Non Food Items UNHCR-DRC	<p>Following the Government's decision, the NFI distribution is going to take place on the 2nd or 3rd week of May and it will cover 440 HHs. Post-distribution monitoring is already planned in the following days.</p>
