





By the end of July 2017, approximately 1.6 million primary health care consultations were provided, representing over 42 per cent of the 2017 overall target, and over 98,500 referrals were made to secondary or tertiary health care. Highlights across the region in July include:

In Lebanon, the number of children under the age of five receiving a routine vaccination saw a sharp increase of 51,487 in July, compared to the month before. This brings the total reach since the beginning of the year to about 94,000. In Iraq, during July 2017 at the Zakho border crossing between Iraq and Syria, immunization teams vaccinated 1,841 children against polio and 731 against measles. Routine vaccinations is available in all nine refugee camps in Iraq. In Egypt, 3RP Partners continue in raising the capacity of Syrian community healthcare workers (CHWs) through the delivery of trainings on the conduct of outreach activities and the reporting system that aims to enhance the monitoring of Syrian CHWs performance, benefitting 170 CHWs from seven governorates this year.
