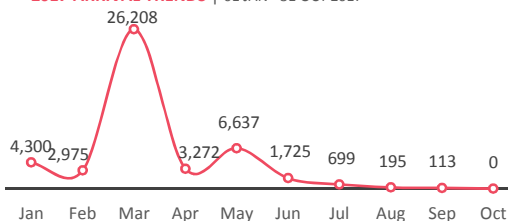
POPULATION DISTRIBUTION



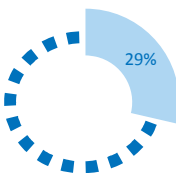

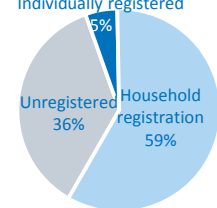
REFUGEE SITE POPULATION



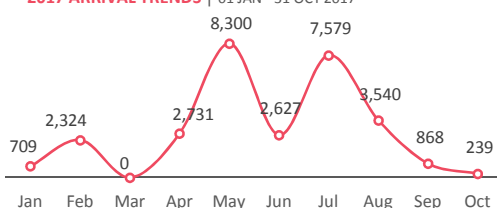
POPULATION DISTRIBUTION



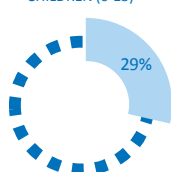

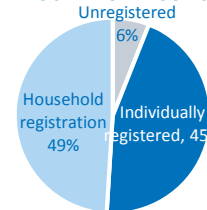

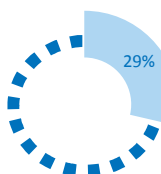

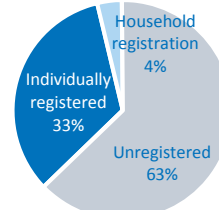

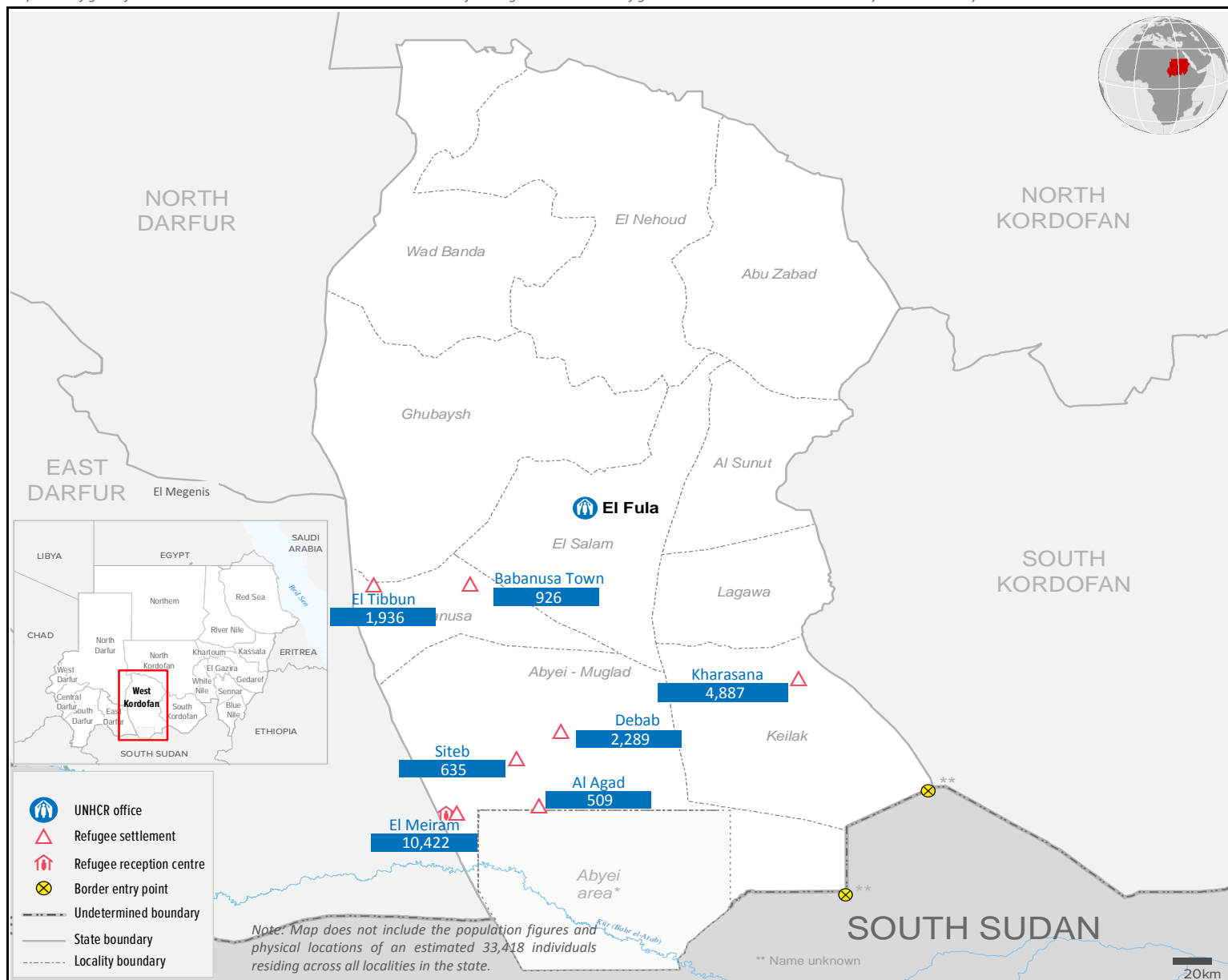
