




### Top 10 nationalities of Mediterranean sea arrivals in Q1-Q3 2017

### Demography of sea arrivals











### Most common countries of asylum in the EU+ (Jan-Aug 2017)

■ Geneva Convention status ■ Subsidiary protection status ■ Humanitarian status ■ Rejected


