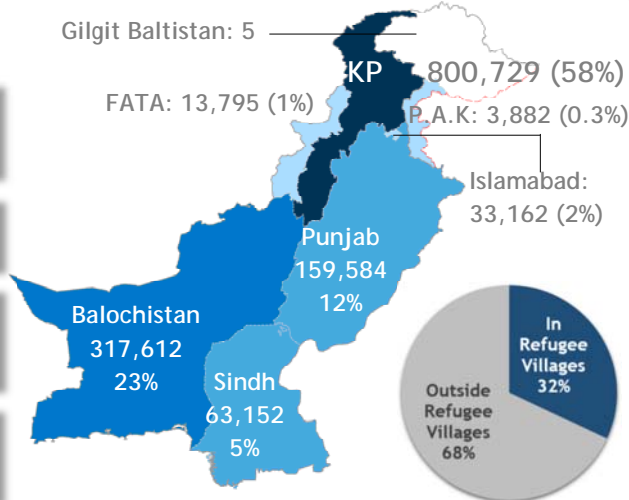

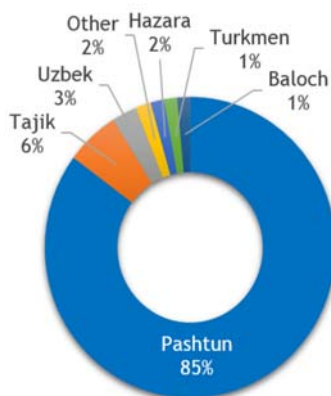

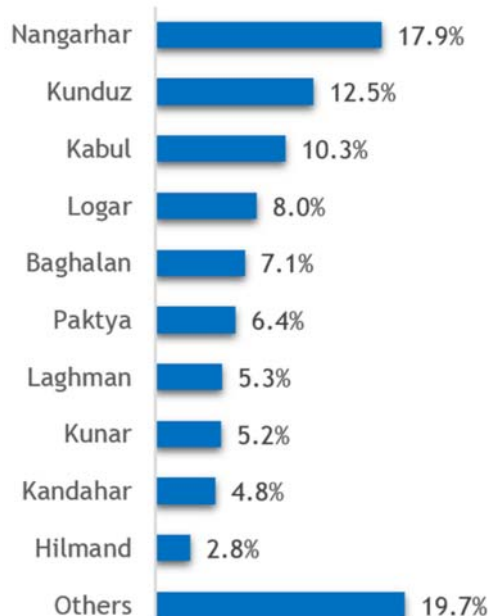

59,020 Facilitated for Voluntary Repatriation from April to November 2017 from Pakistan, out of 59,020 the total number of individuals entitled for cash assistance is 57,426. Remaining 1,594 received UNHCR's cash assistance in the past. Voluntary repatriation program has been suspended on 30 November 2017 due to winter break and it will again resume on 1 March 2018.

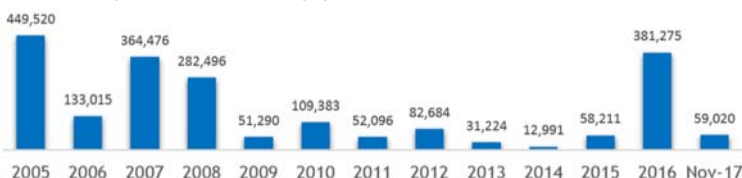

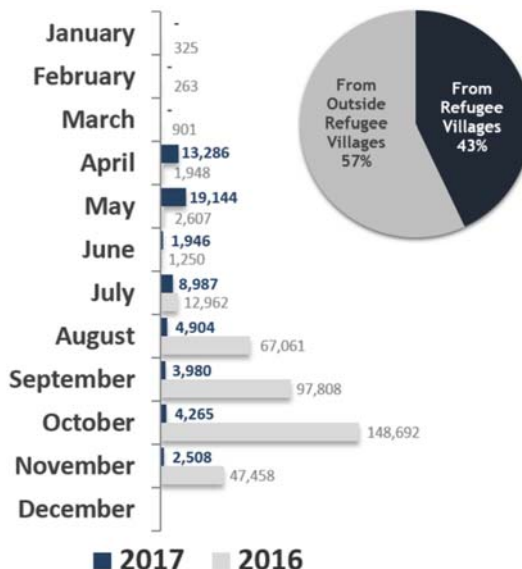

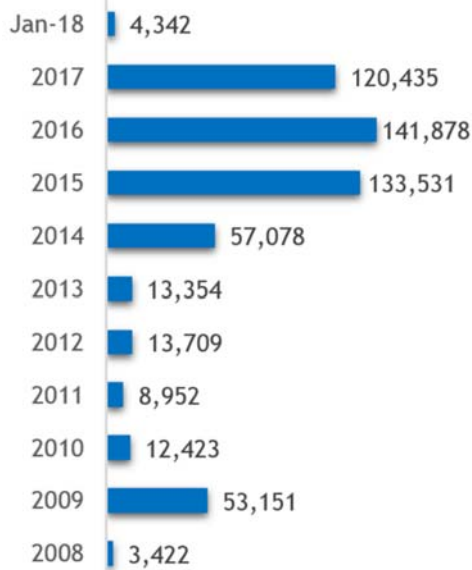

In 2018, UNHCR's target is for the registration of 90,000 new births, as well as the issuance of approximately 90,000 birth certificates. The target for the issuance of individual PoR cards is 130,000 children who have reached five years of age and are eligible to receive their individual cards from the PCM centres.

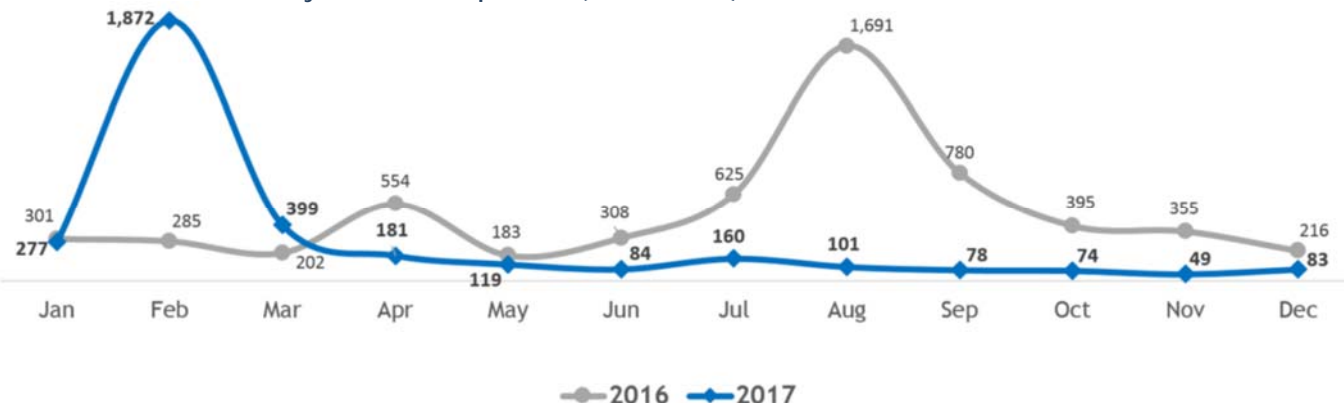
