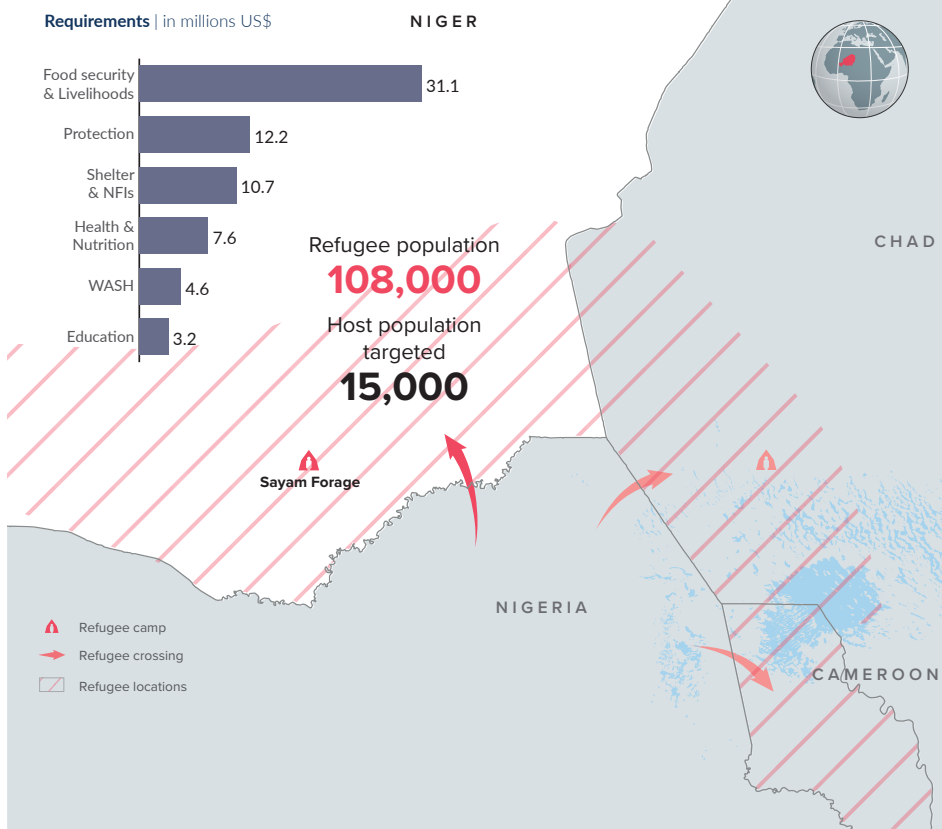

## STRATEGIC RESPONSE

In 2018, 108,000 refugees and 15,000 hosts will be assisted in Niger, while an estimated 30,000 refugees may opt to return voluntarily. Further to ensuring biometric registration of the entire displaced population in the region, additional monitoring staff will be deployed to monitor pendular population movements. Partners will continue to support Niger authorities to ensure durable infrastructure is established at key displacement sites for those refugees settled outside Sayam Forage refugee camp. There are currently approximately 147 out of camp sites hosting refugees in the region. These interventions will be coupled with investments in the provision of alternative energy to refugee households and legal access to land through the Urbanization programme. In order for RRP partners to be able to focus on emergency response, they will seek the support of development actors, who will focus on more durable projects aimed at assisting authorities with transitioning out of the emergency response.
