1.	Katsikas – Non formal and Formal Education	No update by MoE or ASB on the status of the 8 MoE containers on the site waiting to be connected to the sewage, water, electricity grid. UNHCR still awaits written request to provide containers for NFE use. Second Tree informed that in cooperation with Arsis they will start English classes after three o'clock on the CFS space.		
2.	Update on continuation of non- formal educational activities – overview by sites and urban accommodation	On the sites of Filippiada, Doliana and Konitsa Greek classes for adults have started. On Filippiada five times per week; on Konitsa three times per week and on Doliana two times per week (same teacher with Konitsa), On Katsikas the Arsis run CFS has had 112 unique users; while the CFS users in konitsa are 23. Furthermore in Katsika Arsis is running a theatrical workshop for adolescents Currently there are 4 PwSN pupils enrolled in primary school for special education that are Solidarity Now beneficiaries.
