

Joint programme between UN and government partners to:


- i) Promote **social stability** and **conflict resolution**; and
- ii) Improve their **employability** (skills-training, youth entrepreneurship, and job placement initiatives)

Majority of activities consist of training, job placement, entrepreneurship, coordination and awareness raising

# HOW I

- UNDP 'Mechanisms for Social Stability (MSS)' → Social economic committees  
Capacity building sessions to integrate peacebuilding concept into livelihood interventions and to promote local socio-economic development
- UNDP 'Employability': Labor Market assessment and dual system
- ILO 'Entrepreneurship' → Know About Business (KAB) and My First Business (MFB) trainings → Awareness raising about entrepreneurship and start-up development (joint-ventures)
- UNICEF 'Employability & Life skills' → 4 Pillars of Life Skills; competency based trainings and employment referral


# HOW II
