




## HIGHLIGHTS

In the first three months of 2018, Basic Needs partners completed the distribution of winter assistance to the most vulnerable households throughout the country, and initiated planning of the Post-Distribution Monitoring. Through the coordination of the IOM-led Winter Task Force, the PDM will demonstrate the efficacy of the assistance provided in meeting the increased needs of the most vulnerable households during the winter period.


Monthly cash assistance continued, with over 1.26 million beneficiaries being reached by the ESSN alone in this period and a further 154k being assisted through other complimentary cash-based interventions.

In February, a workshop on Shelter programming was conducted with the aim of drawing on current experience and expertise to develop minimum guidelines for shelter programming and a related decision tree to guide actors in their planning of such shelter engagement. The Guidelines have been drafted and have been shared with Protection and Livelihoods sectors for relevant inputs and to strengthen linkages on this topic.

In 2018, support to municipal service delivery remains a priority. To date, the construction has been completed on two waste transfer stations in Hatay and Sanliurfa and four municipal service vehicles for waste collection have been delivered to Gaziantep municipality. Similarly, six firefighting vehicles and four cleaning vehicles have been provided to Kilis, Gaziantep and Hatay municipalities. The support on these particular activities was initiated in 2017.


