	 Islamic Relief: Awaiting a medical Mission from Islamic Relief Canada, which will provide a 1 year project supporting Cataract surgeries and other eye surgeries with free specialists' consultations at Al Hamshari Hospital. Start date is in April 2018. All ages and nationalities are eligible. Islamic Relief to share an official email to be shared with partners. In-kind donation to Bent Jbeil Governmental Hospital with 4 Dialysis machines. Opportunities for support with dialysis treatment for patient who don't have any sponsor to be explored further. Support with SHC fees. Islamic Relief to share further details in order to guide referrals. 	Ibrahim (Islamic Relief)
	 MoPH Accelerated immunization activities have been completed in Saida district and Nabatieh governorate. Results are not yet finalized. Some partners are establishing contracts with PHC centers without informing MoPH. Organizations are expected to consult through the health coordination working group before conducting their activities. Caritas PHCc in Saida is no longer supported by CARITAS, and will only be supported under MADAD through IMC. EPHRP will end in 2018. Partners to emphasize appropriate requests for medications by PHC centers. 	Faten (MoPH)
