## Health Analysis Report Rukban Clinic - May 2018





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## 63% of secondary and tertiary referrals were for obstetrics & gynaecology.



- Urinary tract infection
- Skin infection
- Lower Respiratory Tract Infection (LRTI)
- Watery diarrhea

Upper respiratory tract infections constituted for the majority of acute health conditions during the month of May (38%). Watery diarrhea proportions have increased compared to the previous month. Skin infections and urinary tract infections proportions showed steady state in the last four months.

- Hypertension
- Diabetes
- Asthma
- Cardiovascular disease
- Ischaemic heart disease

During the month of May, hypertension constituted for 37% of all chronic consultations, an increase if compared to the previous two months, while diabetes consultations have increased when compared to April. The trends in chronic health conditions vary due to clinic accessibility challenges. Management of chronic diseases requires regular periodic visits to monitor diseases and evaluate therapeutic outcomes which necessitates enhanced accessibility of those morbid diseases to the health care facility.









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
