

UAC shelters

- Current: 51 UAC shelters with total **1,125** places

SIL (Supported Independent Living) apartments

- Current: 4 SIL apartments for UAC older than 16 years old with total 16 places


Safe zones* (short-term)

- Current: 10 Safe Zones for UAC with total 300 places

Hotels** (emergency)

- Current: 12 Hotels for UAC with total **550** places

- *Safe Zones are designated supervised spaces within accommodation sites which provide UAC with 24/7 emergency protection and care. They should be used as short term (maximum 3 months) measures to care for UAC in light of the insufficient number of available shelter places. Safe Zone priority is given to UAC in detention as well as other vulnerable children, in line with their






