<u>SHELTER & NFI</u>

625 households living in adequate shelters in the camp following refurbishment of existing shelters with local, durable materials

PROTECTION

- 78% of refugees registered

- 2,446 refugees aged 18+ years were the holders of an identity document
- 422 persons with special needs received adequate assistance
