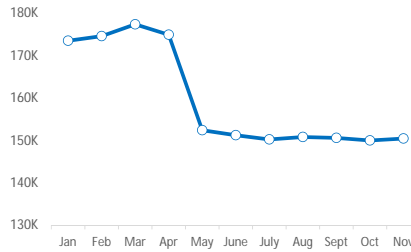

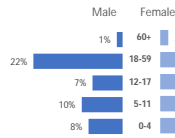

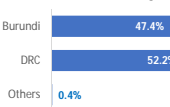

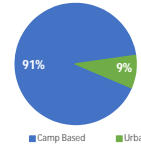

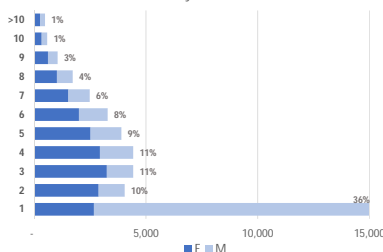

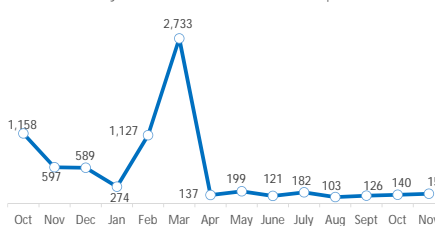

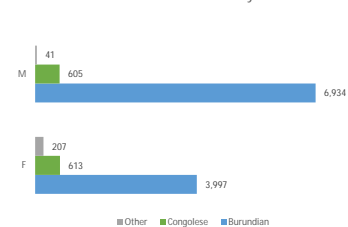
Family Size Breakdown
