Updates from YTF members on youth programming

Youth Programming:

- IRD with UNFPA is establishing a community and training center for workers and cash for work volunteers working in the camp. It is expected to be ready by end of May and will be building the capacity of service providers on sexual and reproductive health and rights, GBV, and Youth. Awareness and messages will also be done through other IRD components. This will contribute to high level capacity building. For the youth training, a Youth workers needs assessment will be conducted to have a clear identification of the youth workers's needs in the camp so that the trainings can be developed based on the these results. A presentation will be given by IRD to the YTF after the assessment results are in.
- Quest Scope/UNFPA Youth Center in D4 is changing from a target group pf 15- 30 to now including 10- 14 year old boys and girls in a gradual approach. The center is integrating the beneficiaries based on categories.

- Finn church: In June, there will be new activities, including sewing and barbering. Otherwise, they have the same activities.
- LWF:- Football, pingpong are new and otherwises the same activities as before are ongoing.

N.B. Ramadan effect on activities for youth overall will be shorter working hours.

Action Point: Agencies should share information for summer period activities to be included in the Newsletter for the next guarter.

1. Newsletter

1st Quarter Newsletter which is due now will focus on activities of the first quarter. All agencies agreed to share their stories from youth in Arabic and English by next YTF meeting.

Action Point: Deadline for newsletter submissions in Arabic and English is Sunday 29th so that Leana can work on a draft version to show in the meeting.

2nd Quarter newsletter will focus on Ramadan activities and summer activities.

Action Point: Leana to share the last newsletter with everyone for agencies to share with youth to understand what kind of stories we are looking for.

Action Point: Maher to share stories on innovation truck for community service and short classes newsletter; and to share story on Internship for electricity and plumbing students.

2. Advocacy messages

The group looked at the existing Advocacy messages to see if they need any updates. It was agreed that the messages would be sent out for people to review and provide feedback on by the next YTF meeting.

Early marriage is still one of the biggest concerns in the camp (top advocacy issue which is cross utting with Child protection, GBV and protection).
