Updates on Non-Formal Education	6-22 years old (NFE/VIAL RIC and off-site):	
	IOM informed the ESsWG participants that the information session on public education to UAC took place and the Secondary education Director, the Public Prosecutor, the RIC Director First Reception, METAdrasi, and UNHCR attended. The outcome of this event was 19 UAC, aged 15-17 years old, expressing interest for attending the public school (Chios EPAL-vocational lyceum). A meeting between the IOM and the Director of First EPAL was arranged in order to address practical issues, such as enrolment procedures and the schedule of the public school. The registration process is under way and the applications are to be signed by the Public Prosecutor. With regard to the transportation, either the Director of EPAL will provide transportation cards to students for free access to the public bus , either IOM will cover the cost of a bus on a daily basis. METAdrasi / RECs informed the participants on the 3-day psychosocial sessions that took place for teenagers, in cooperation with Praksis. The aim of these sessions is for children to develop good interrelations in view of their transportation to RSRE (DYEP) school.
