

600,000 Jan - Jun 2018


The UNHCR-led PRMN implemented in partnership with NRC reported 39,000 new internal displacements in the month of June 2019. Of these, 24,000 were triggered by conflict/insecurity, 12,000 by drought related, 1,000 by floods and 2,000 due to other reasons.




Conflict/insecurity continued to be the leading cause of displacement in the month of June. Of the individuals monitored, 10,000 were reported in Lower Shabelle region as a result of military offensive against armed militia groups. Clan conflicts in Hiraan and Galgaduud regions have displaced more than 10,000 in the reporting month.




Drought related displacements reported by PRMN partners were similar to the month of May. Lack of livelihood (6,000) was the main reason that led to drought related displacements.


