



Six-month requirements versus shortfalls - FOOD




Sum of Resourced (nb) Shortfalls (nb) NB: need-based plan



- Super Cereal (CSB) with sugar commodity pipeline break in March – WFP will substitute with CSB and sugar purchased separately to cover the needs in March.
- From April onwards this commodity will be available for purchase in Rwanda
- In August WFP will break for maize and vegetable oil
- Beans are available until October 2019

Six-month requirements versus shortfalls - CASH


- WFP will face a cash pipeline break in mid-July 2019.
- However, WFP foresees that it will be able to secure funding for all of July 2019 at least.
