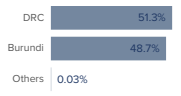

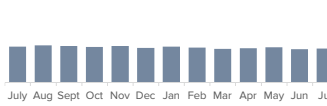

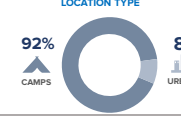
### MAIN COUNTRIES OF ORIGIN



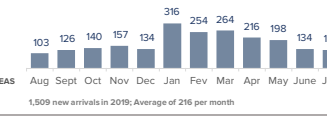
### MONTHLY POPULATION TRENDS | July 2018 - July 2019



### DISTRIBUTION OF POPULATION BY LOCATION TYPE

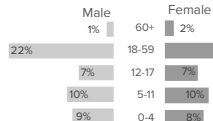
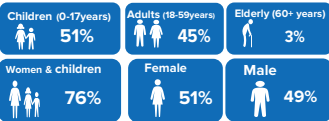

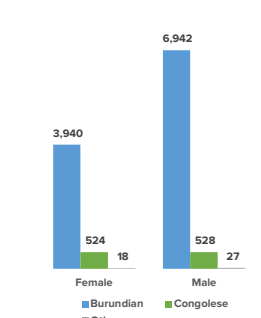

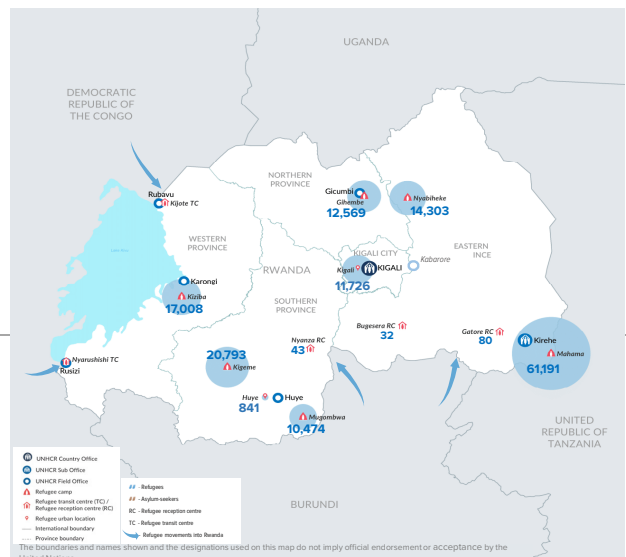

### POPULATION DISTRIBUTION BY LOCATION IN RWANDA

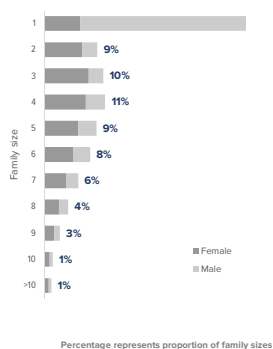
