<p>1: 3RP 2019-2020 Planning</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3RP Planning Timeline was presented - It was discussed that the narrative part should refer to the recent trends in social cohesion subject, economic outlook of the country and presidential system. -There is a need for more discussions amongst sectors about referrals and vulnerability criteria to be applied in referral systems, since the definition of vulnerability can be different than protection perspective. -ILO suggested that the emphasize should be more on job creation and inclusion into social security schemes instead of short-term employment. It was also discussed that transition from BN to LH might need to be elaborated more. -WFP suggested to elaborate more on developments regarding M&E as well as strengthening public institutions.
