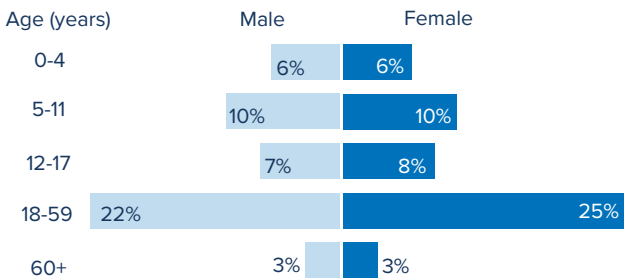

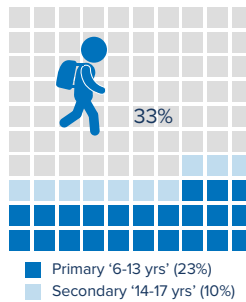

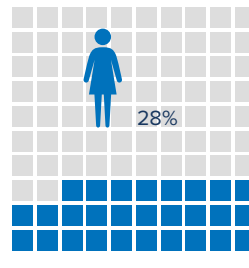

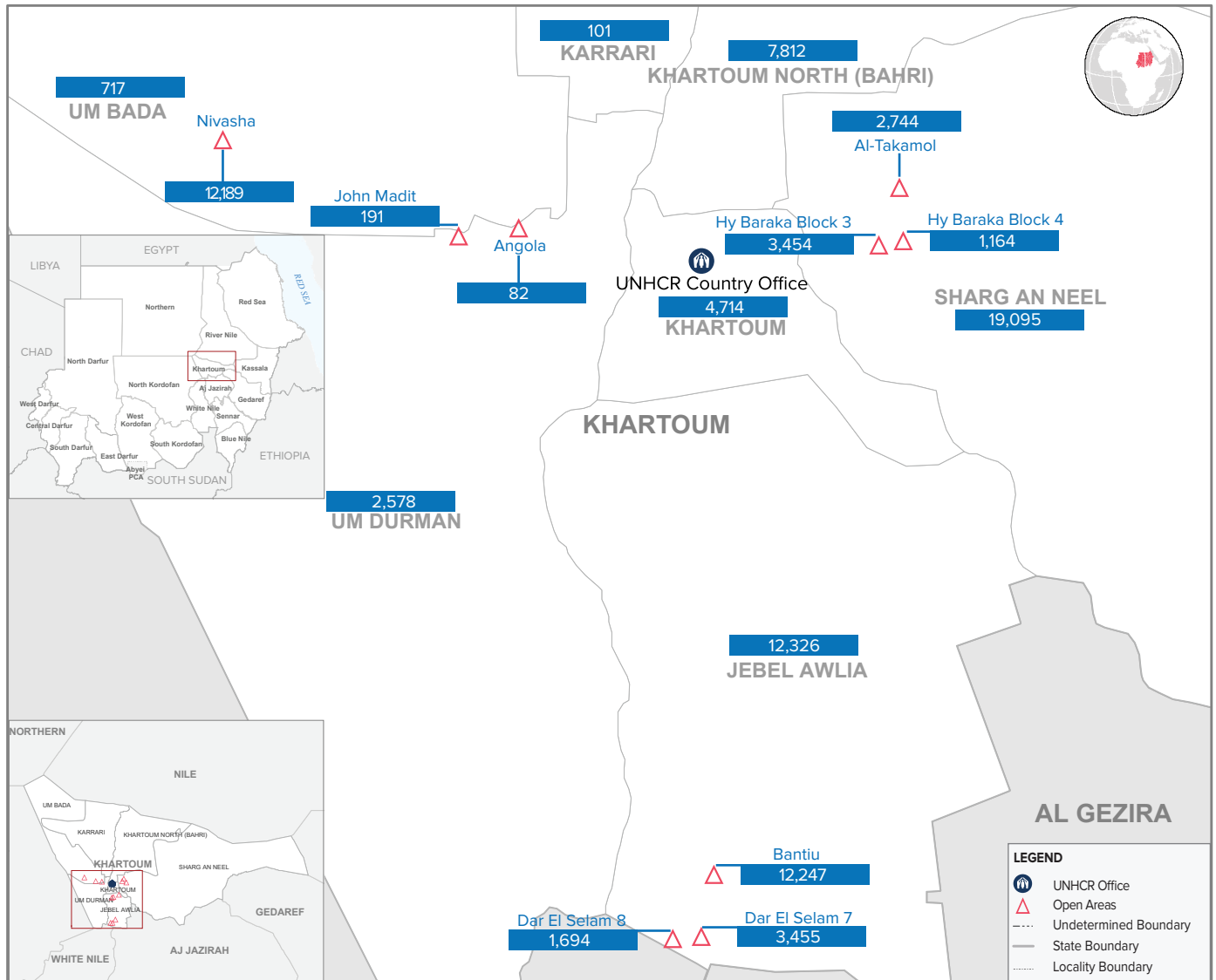
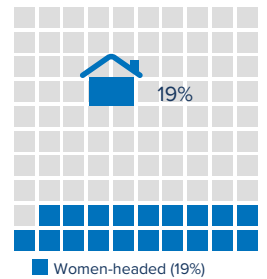
SCHOOL- AGED CHILDREN (6-17 YRS)⁴

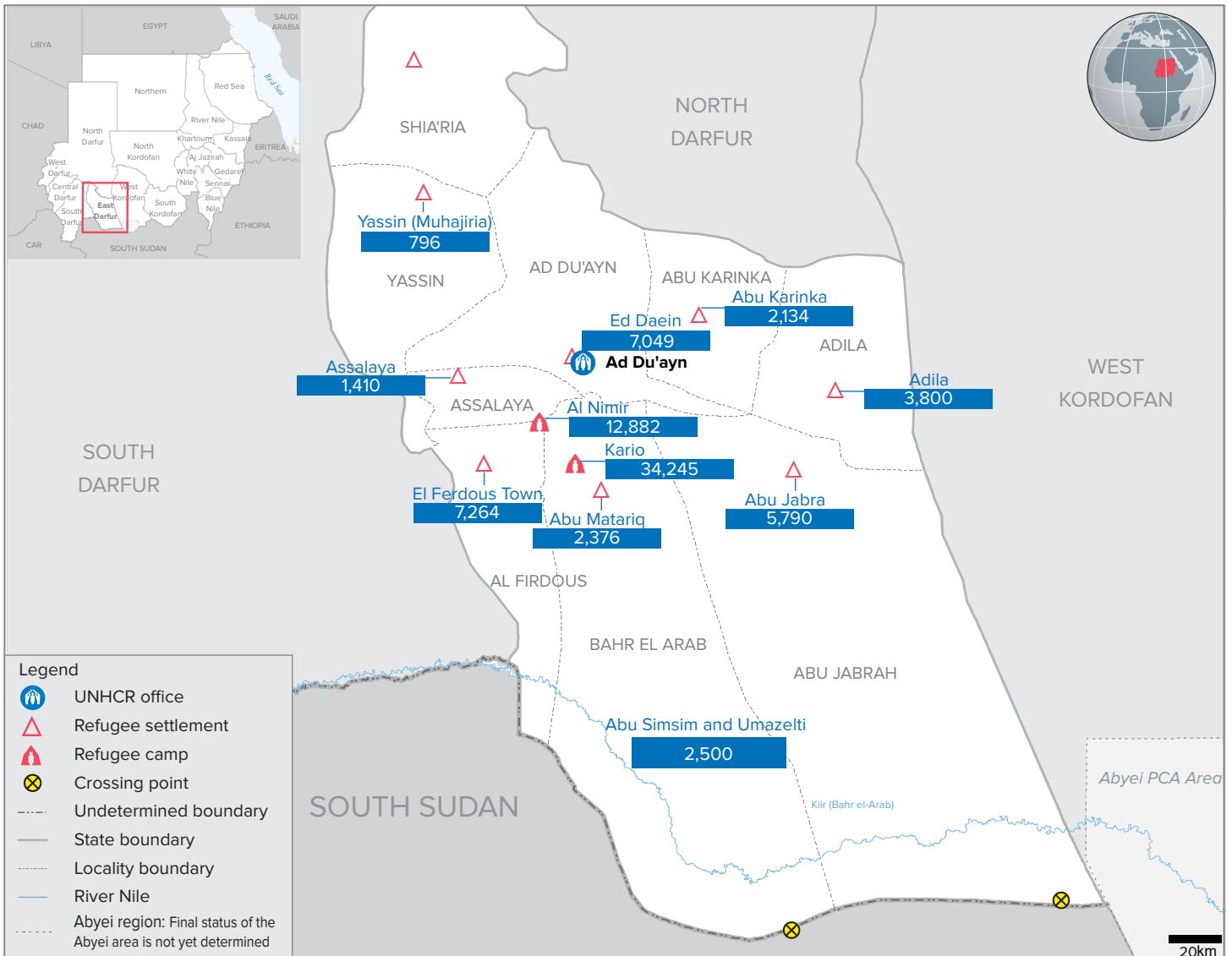

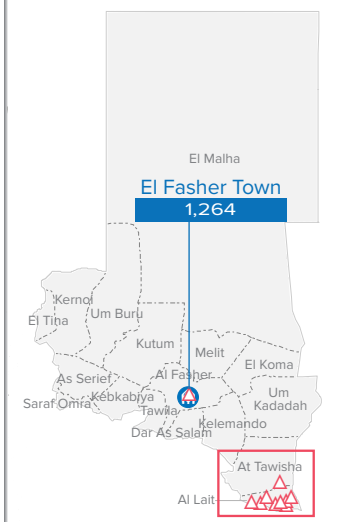

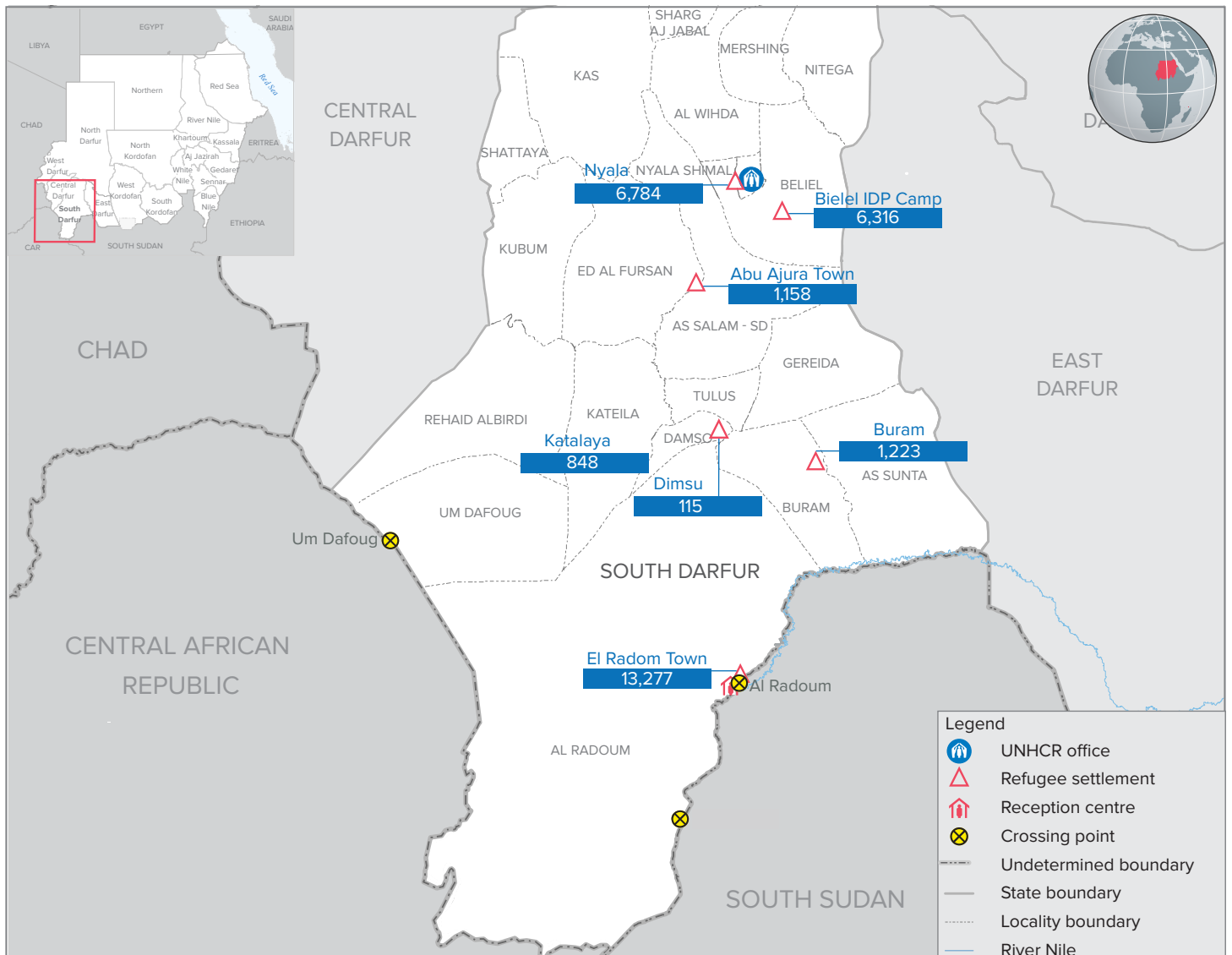

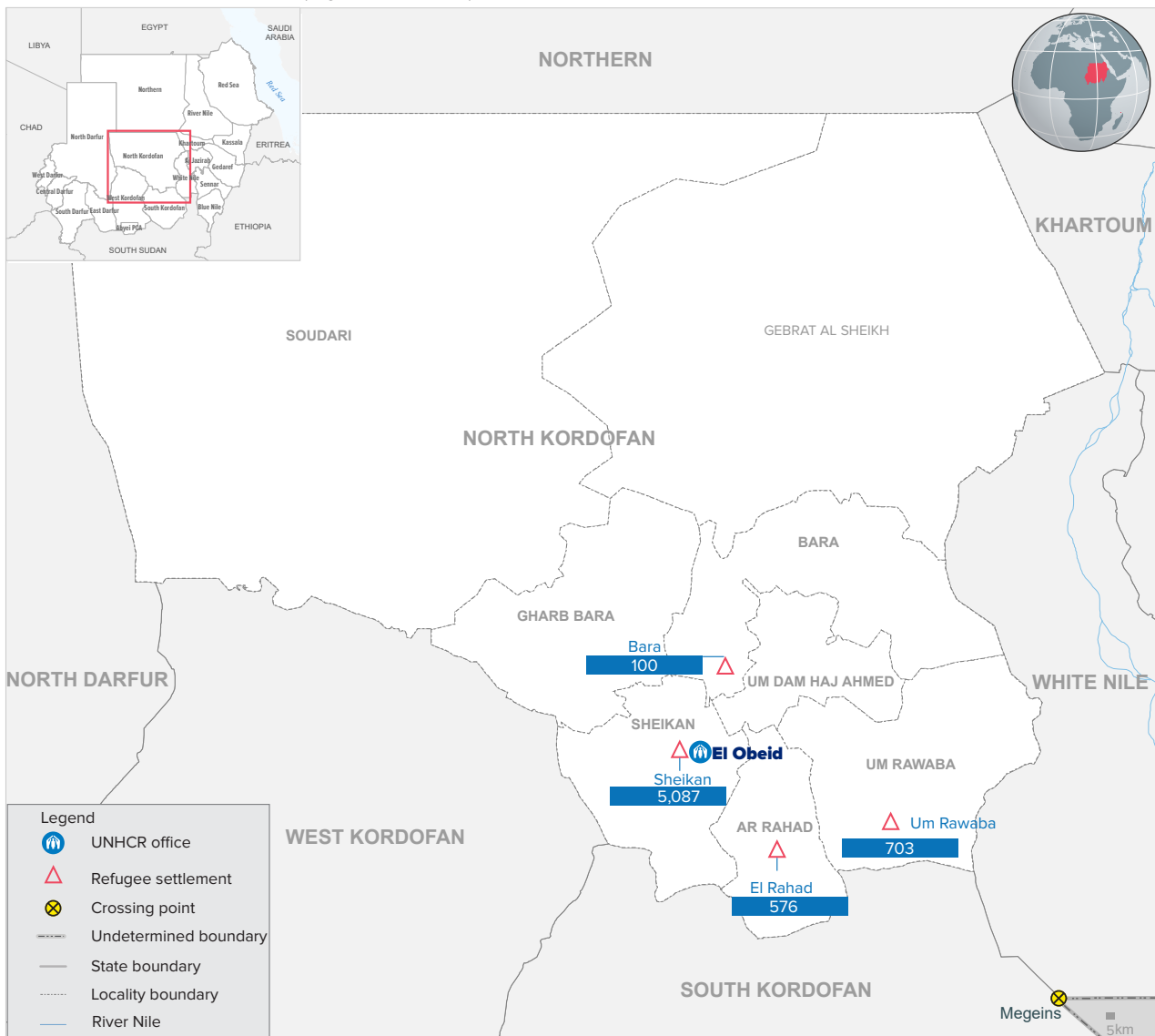

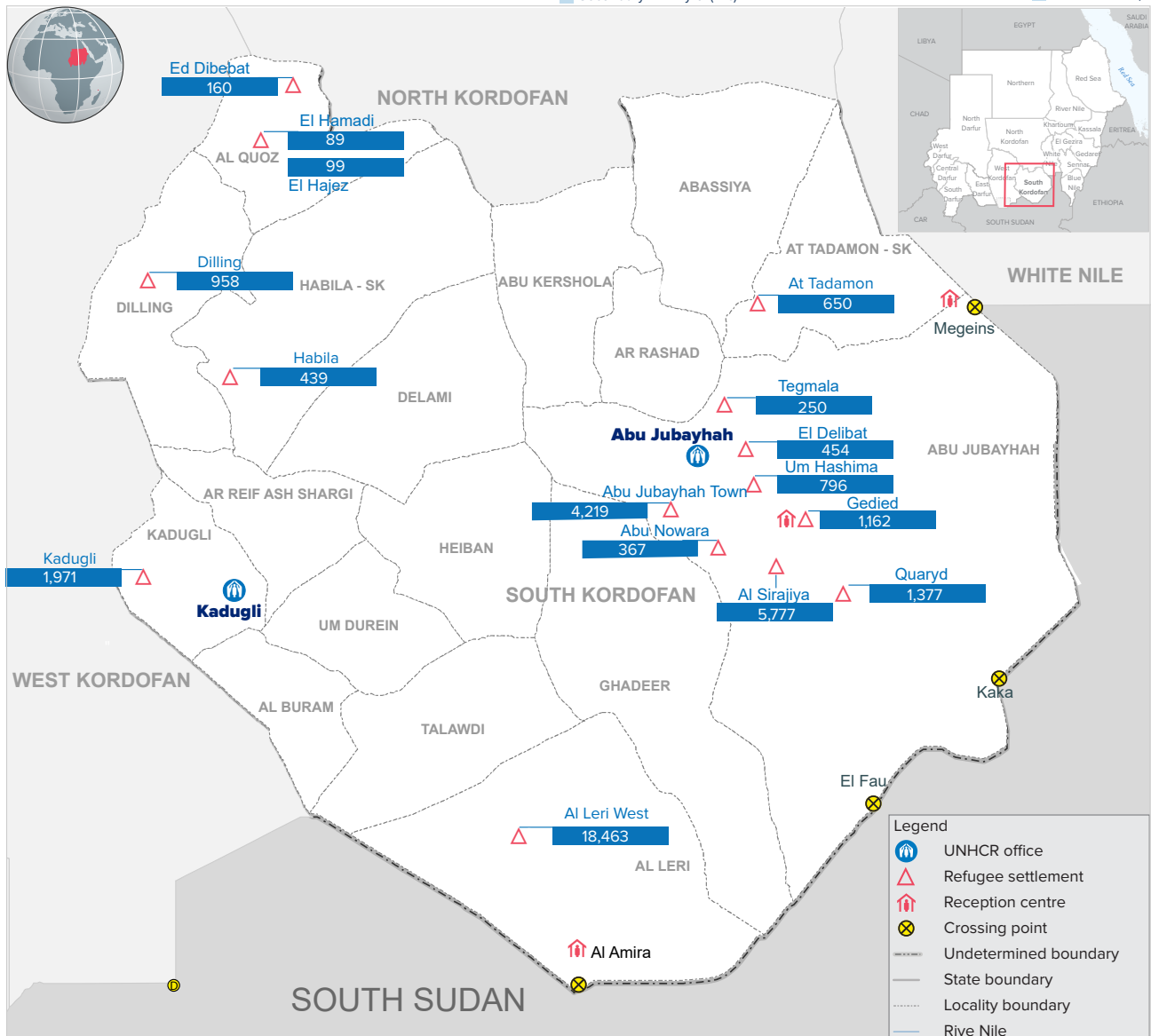

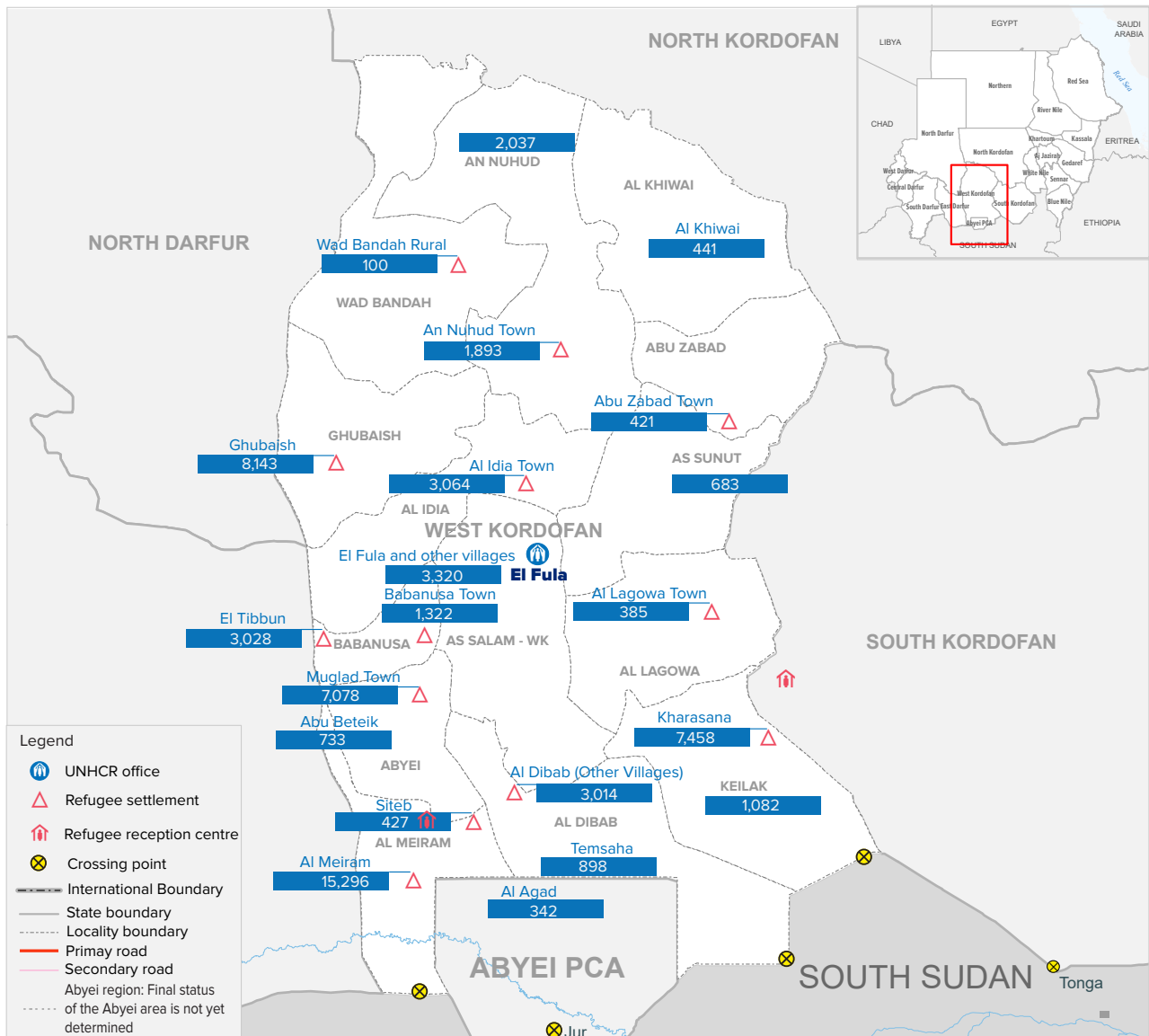

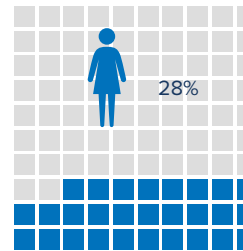

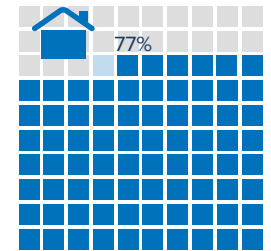

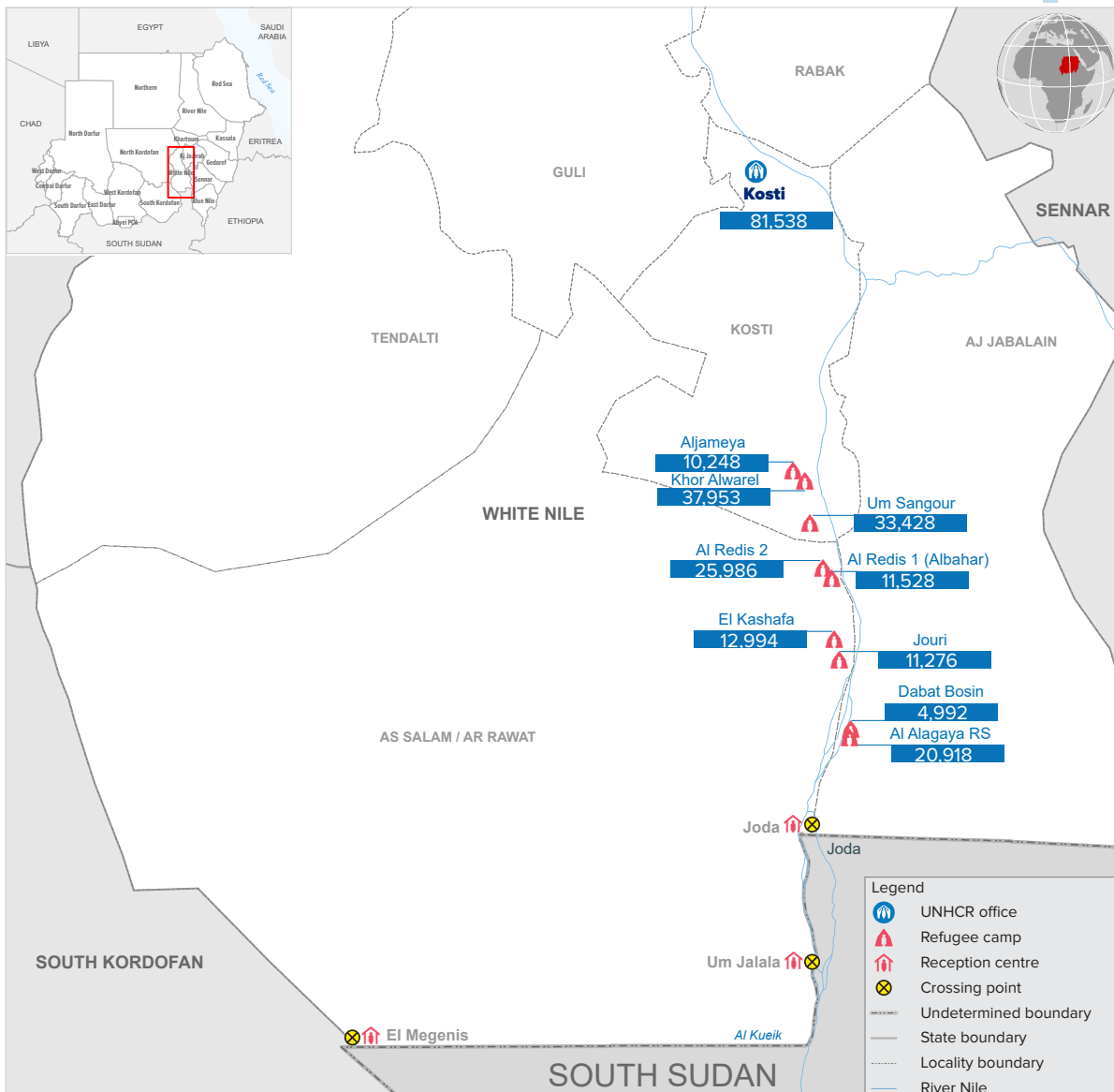
