


ITALY Sea arrivals dashboard

Overview


Between 1 January and 30 April 2020, 3,465 persons arrived in Italy by sea. This is a 345% increase compared to sea arrivals in the same period last year (779). In April 2020, 671 individuals reached Italian shores, compared to 255 in April 2019. **3,465** Jan - Apr 2020 **779** Jan - Apr 2019



Nationality of arrivals

Between January and April 2020, 14% of persons who arrived by sea originated from Bangladesh, followed by Côte d'Ivoire (14%), Sudan (10%), Algeria (9%), Morocco (7%), Somalia (6%), Tunisia (6%), Guinea (5%), Mali (5%), Egypt (2%). In the same period last year, the most common nationalities of sea arrivals were Tunisia, Algeria, Iraq, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Guinea, Senegal, Somalia, Côte d'Ivoire and Islamic Republic of Iran. In April, there was an increase (485%) of nationals of Côte d'Ivoire (158) and (3533%) of Sudanese nationals (109) compared to March. Notably, 35% of nationals of Côte d'Ivoire were women.


Most common nationalities of arrivals - January 2019 to April 2020





Country of embarkation


In the first four months of 2020, 65% of sea arrivals in Italy (2,261 persons) departed from Libya, followed by 20% (701 persons) from Tunisia, 9% (296 persons) from Algeria, 4% (131 persons) from Greece, and 2% (76 persons) from Albania. The departures from Libya have sharply increased (of 982%) in 2020 if compared to the first four month of 2019.

Between 1 January and 30 April 2020, most sea arrivals were adult men (68%), followed by unaccompanied and separated children (17%), adult women (10%) and accompanied children (5%). In April 2019 11 women arrived in Italy, while in April 2020 108 arrived. In the first four months of 2020 a total of 363 arrived, mostly nationals of Côte d'Ivoire (166), Guinea (35), Somalia (29) and Morocco (28), followed by Cameroon (21), Mali (19), Nigeria (10) and Libya (7).

In 2020 so far, most UASC arriving by sea originated from Bangladesh (163), followed by Côte d'Ivoire (67), Guinea (64), Somalia (63), Tunisia (40), Eritrea (33) and Sudan (28). In April 2019, UASC originated mainly from Tunisia (20) followed by Côte d'Ivoire (2).
