









**Note on border closures as part of COVID-19 containment measures**

- Uganda suspended the reception of new refugees and asylum seekers until further notice on 22 March 2020 following confirmation of COVID-19 in the country.
- Goladjo and Mount Zeu border crossing points were re-opened in Zombo district from 1-3 July 2020 in order to provide a safe haven for DRC asylum-seekers fleeing violence\*.
