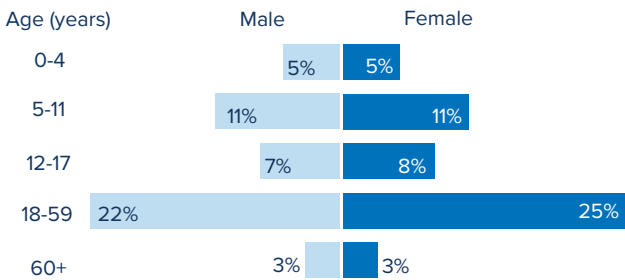

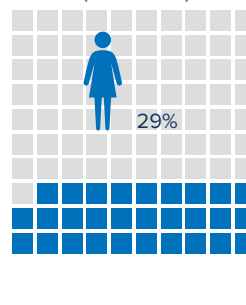

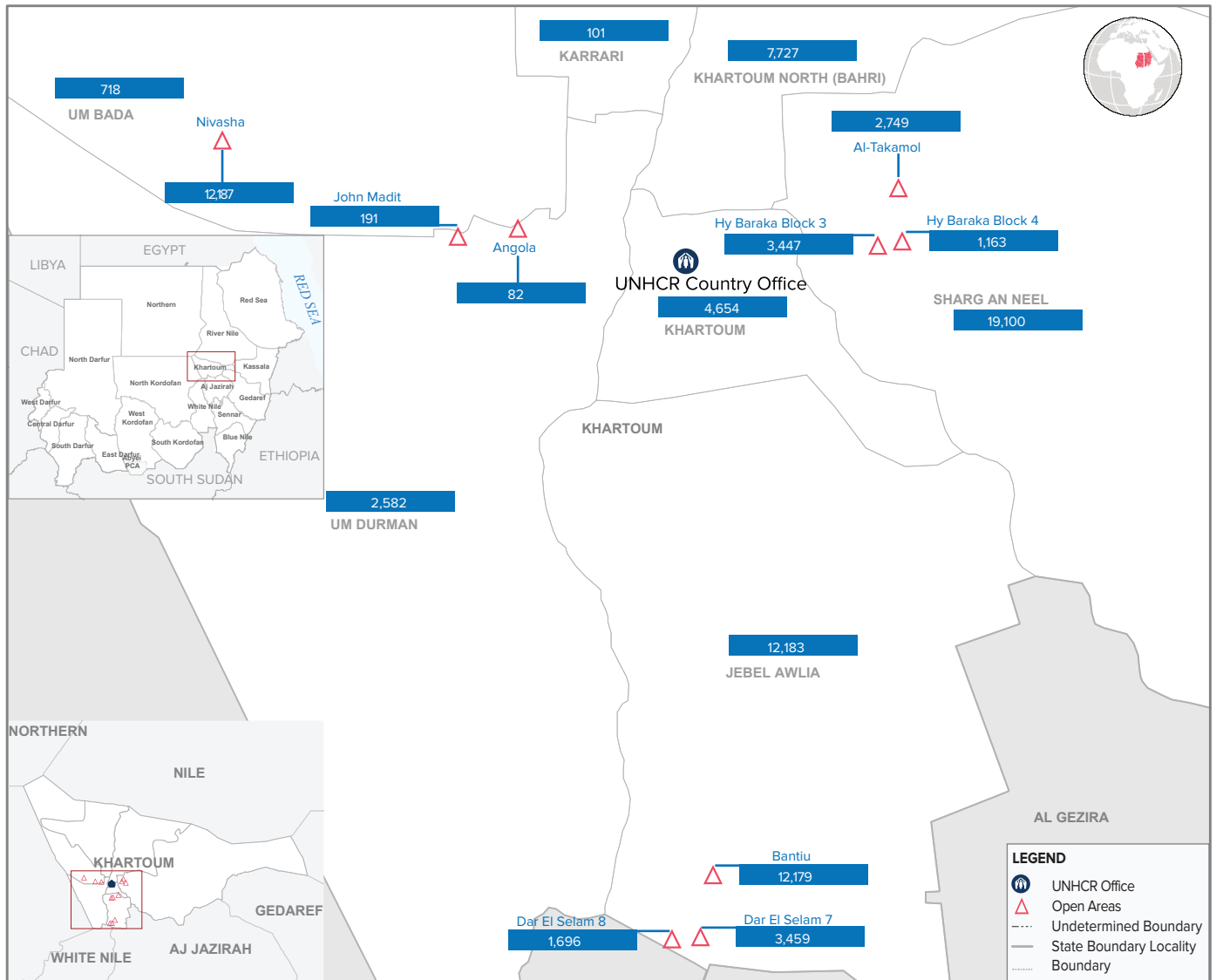
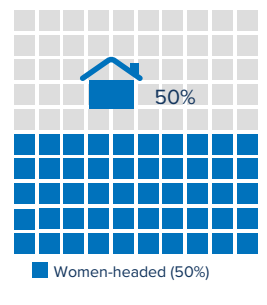
SCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN (6-17 YRS)<sup>3</sup>

HOUSEHOLD DISTRIBUTION<sup>3</sup>



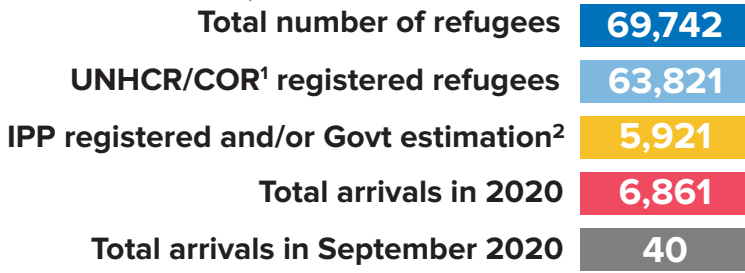

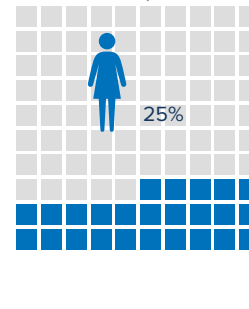

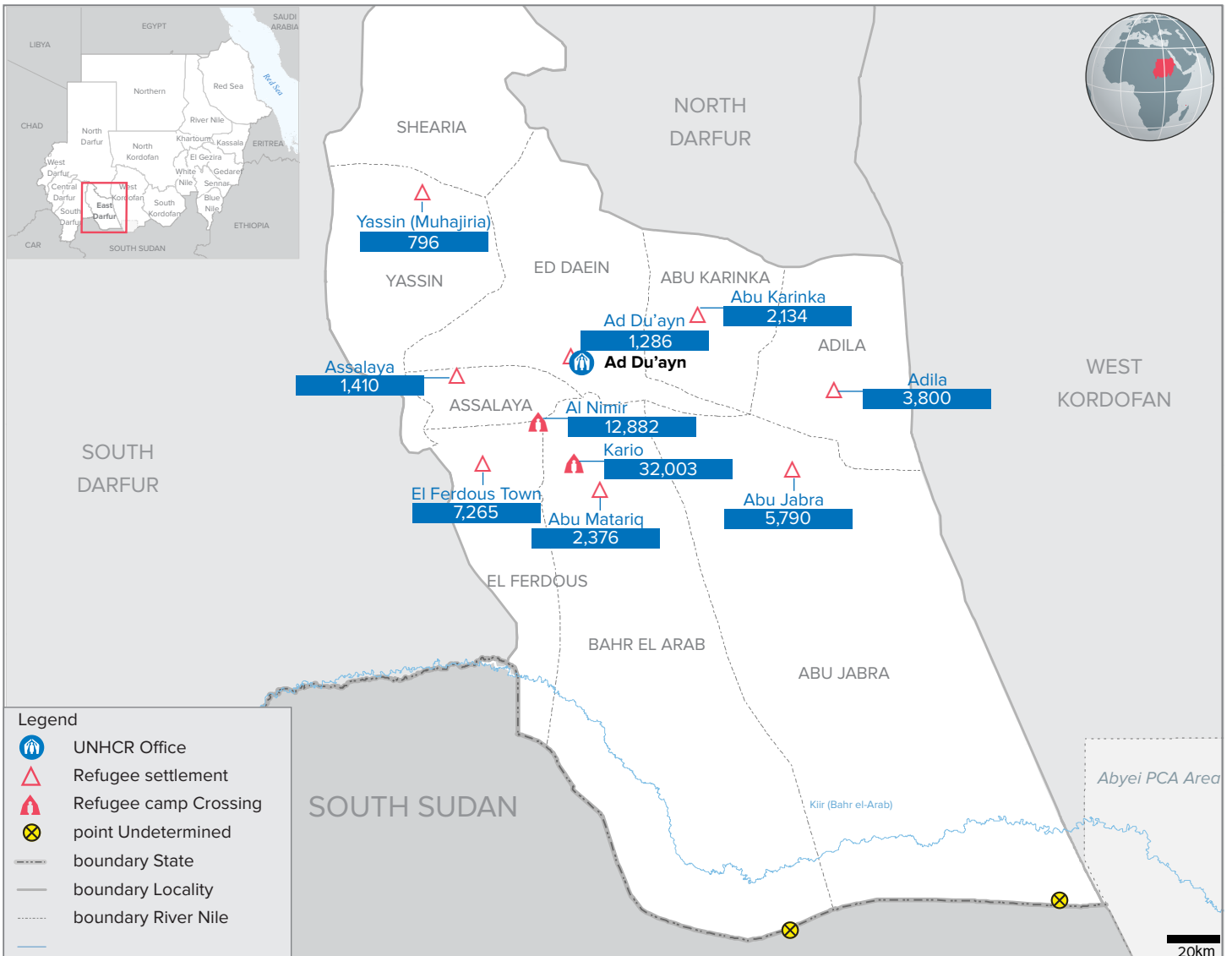
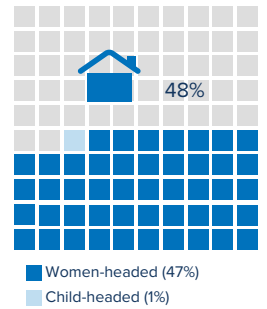
SCHOOL-AGE CHILDREN (6-17 YRS)<sup>3</sup>

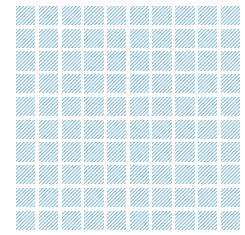

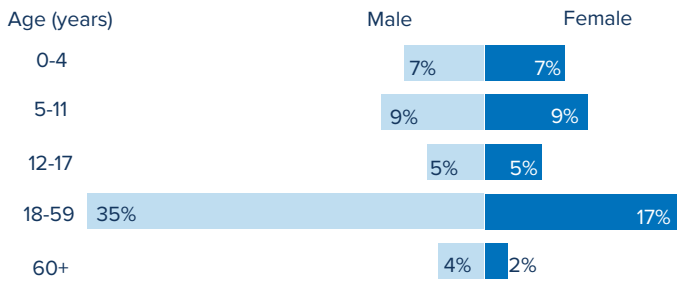

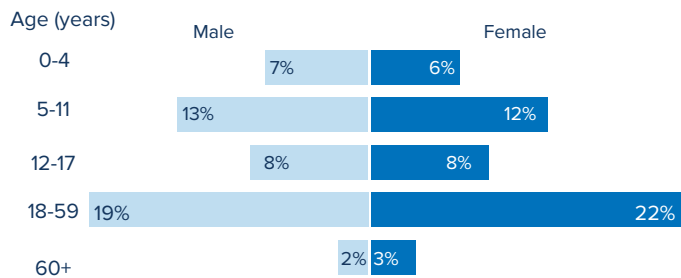

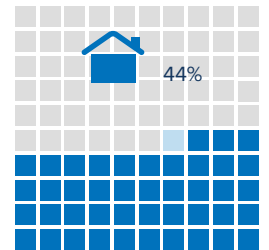

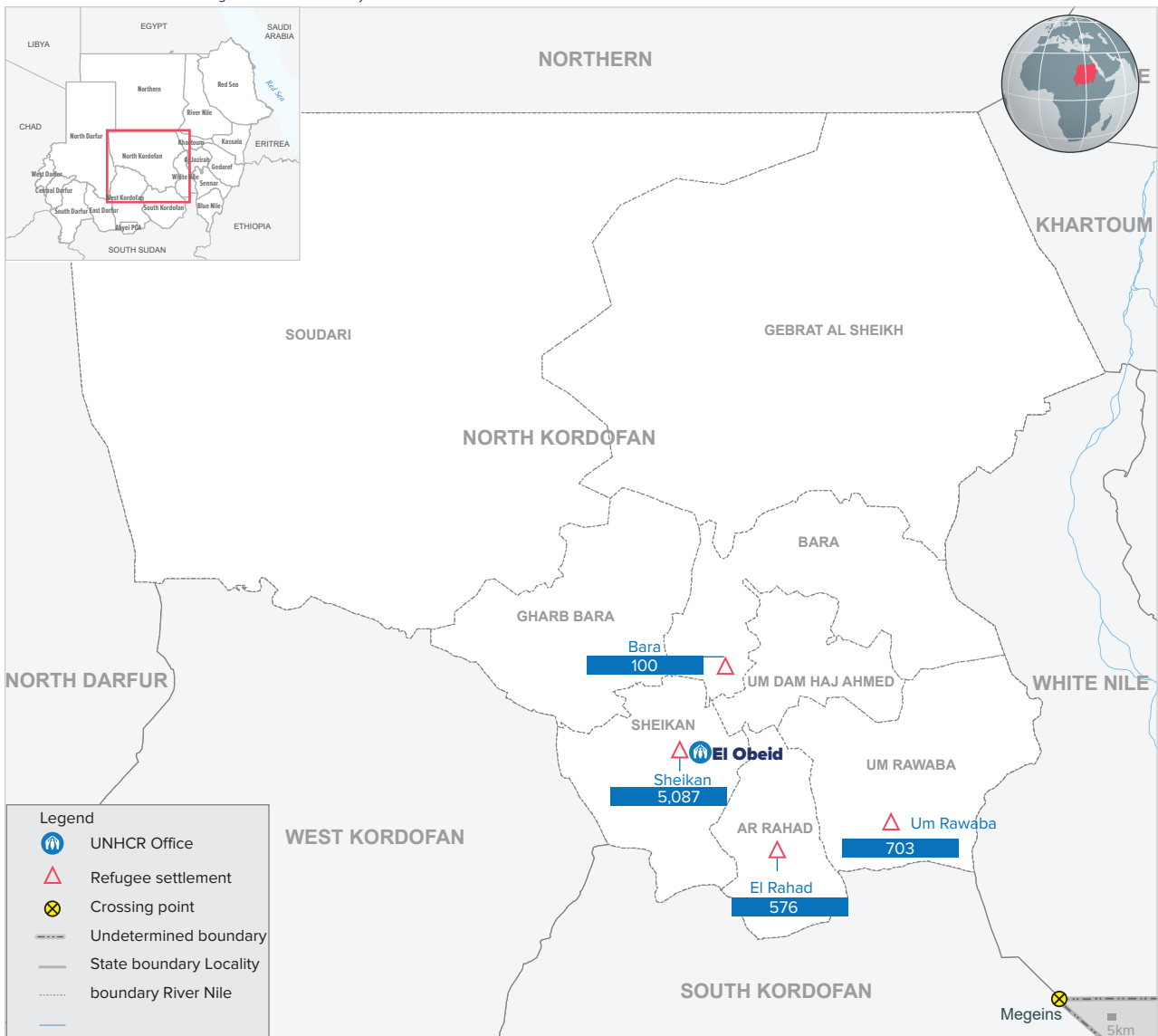

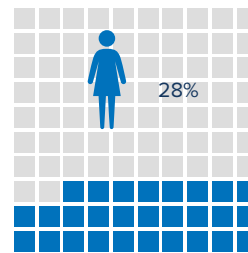

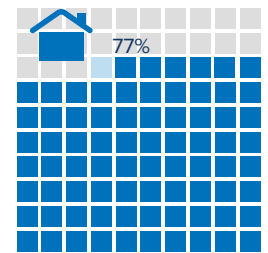

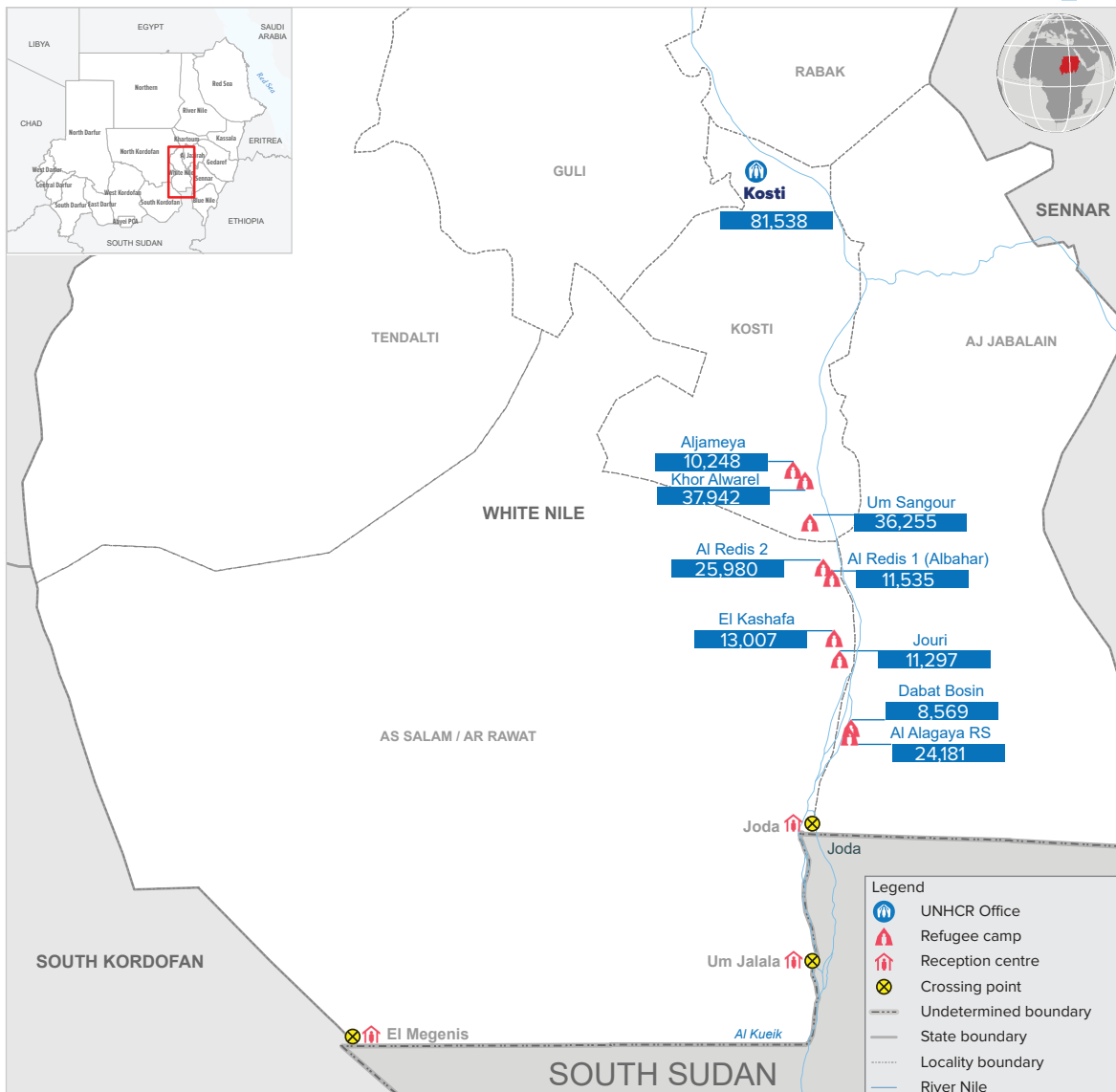
