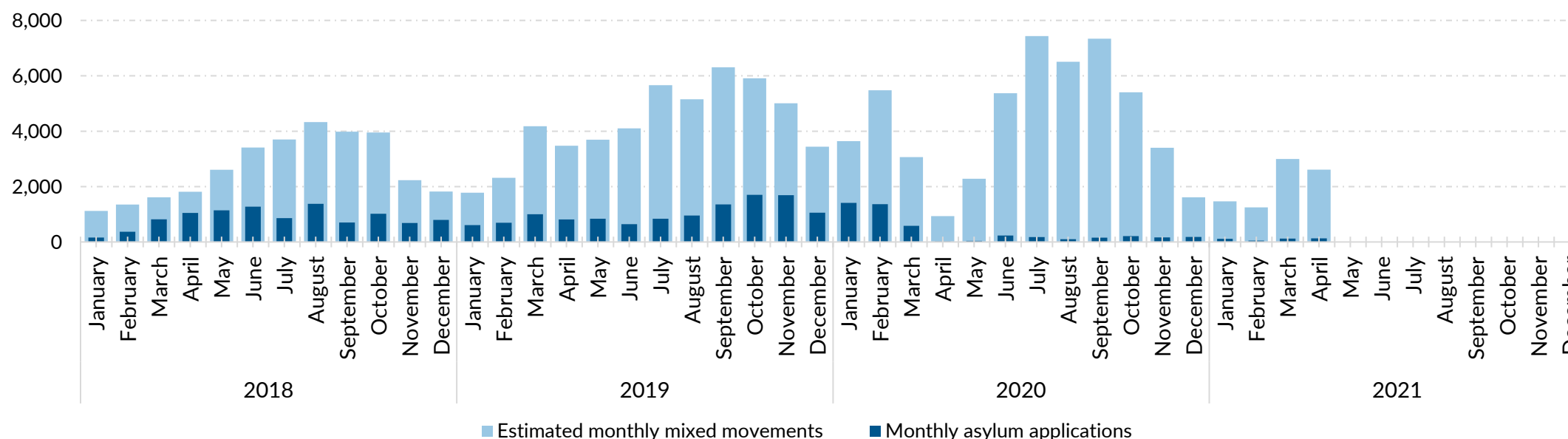
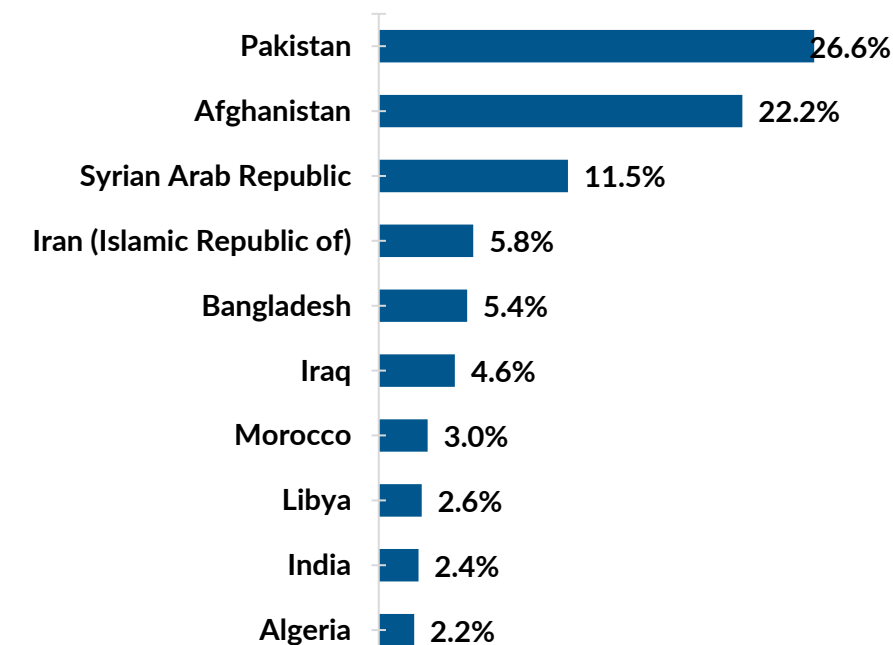

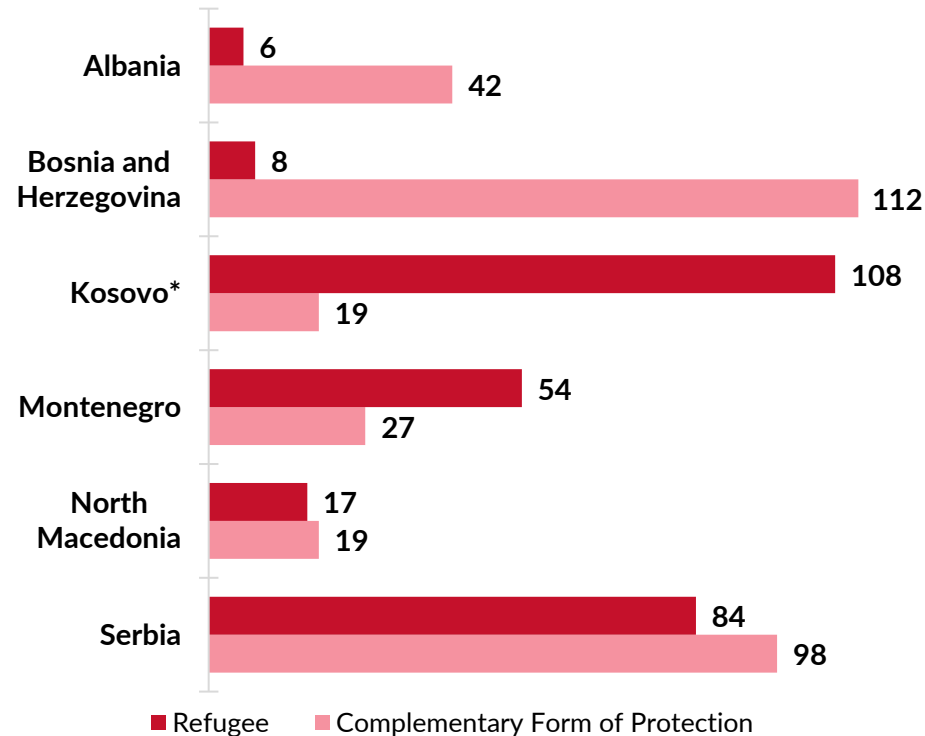
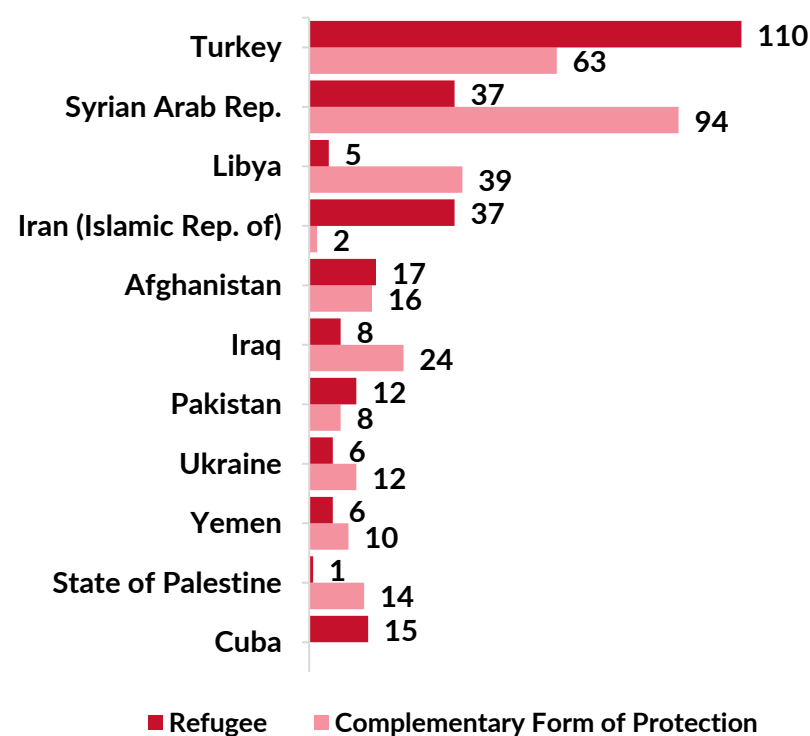
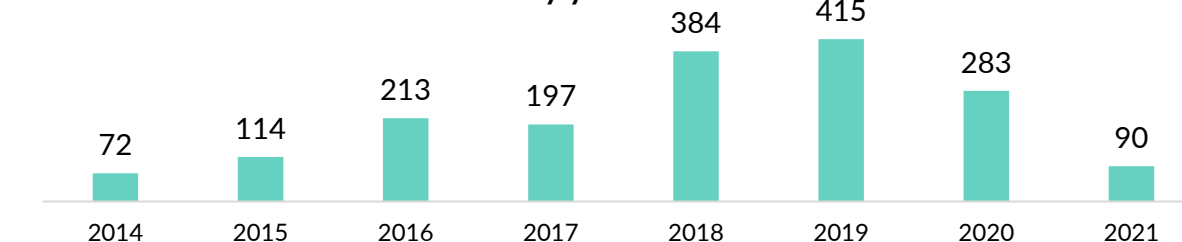
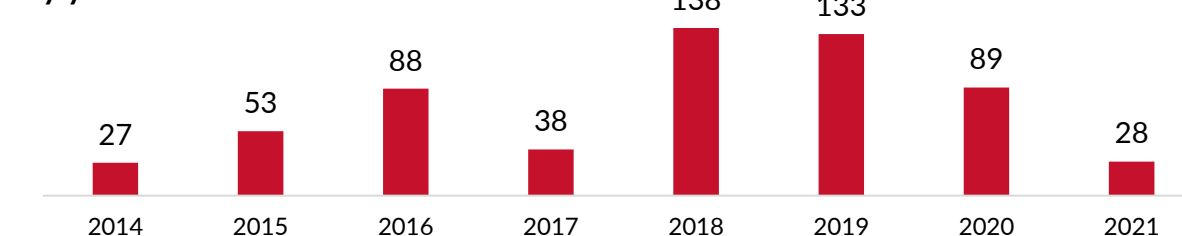
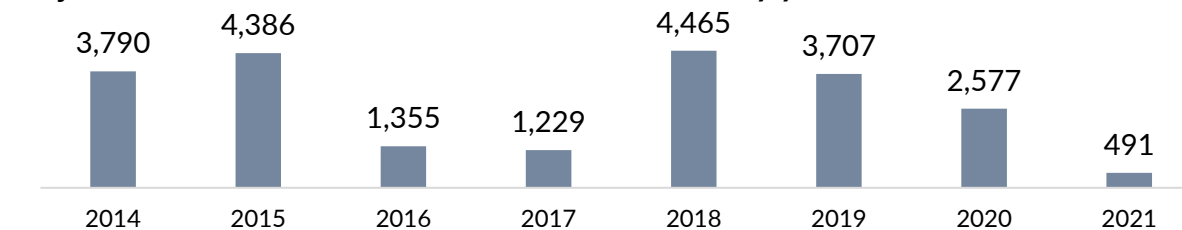

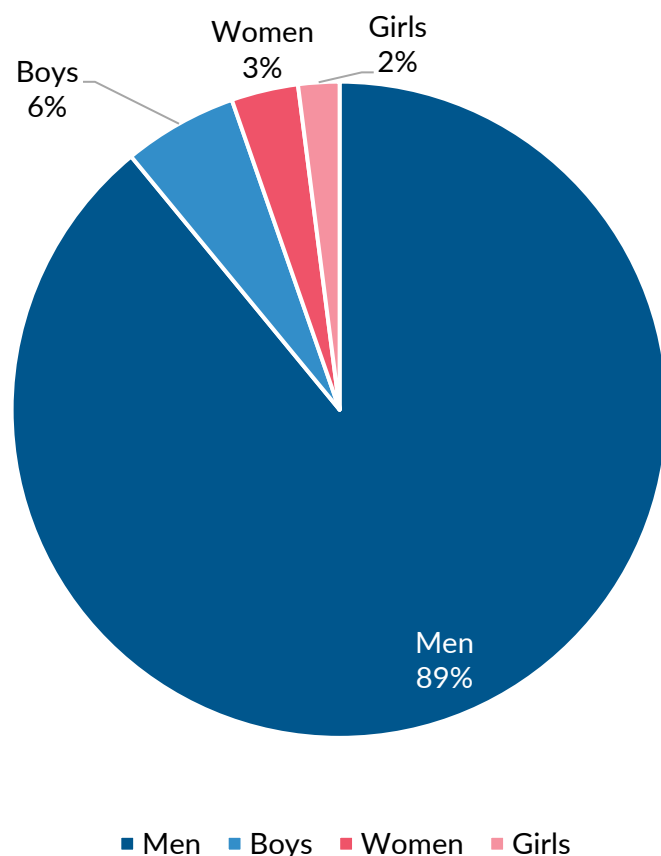
Key demographic figures at Regional level

Adults in the mixed migration represent **89%** in % in 2021 in the Western Balkans

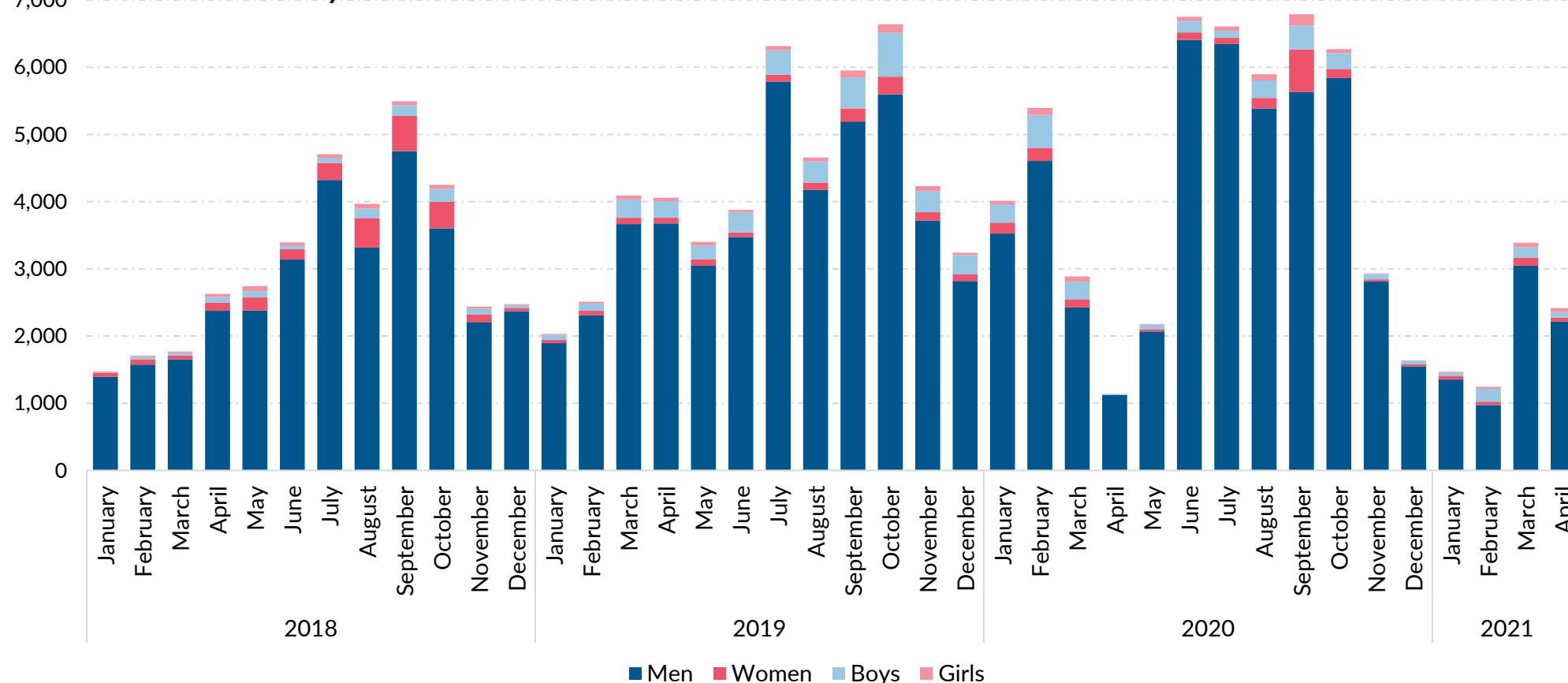
Children in the mixed migration represent in % in 2021 in the Western Balkans **7.6%**
