




Registered Syrian Refugees in Host Countries

Demography of registered Syrian refugees



Key figures

66.3% of people in need in the region are women or children

95% of Syrian refugees across the region reside within the host community, mainly in urban areas; 5 % reside in camps

Some 35% of children are out of school and a significant number of children are missing out on distance learning opportunities

In 2020, **over 60%** of the households reported loss of job and entire income due to the pandemic in some countries




***The numbers for Lebanon are based on end of May reporting. Changes in UNHCR IT infrastructure in Lebanon have resulted in temporary reporting delays.




Regional Return Trends: 2018-2021




Regional Monthly Average

Returns by Sex & Age in 2021






