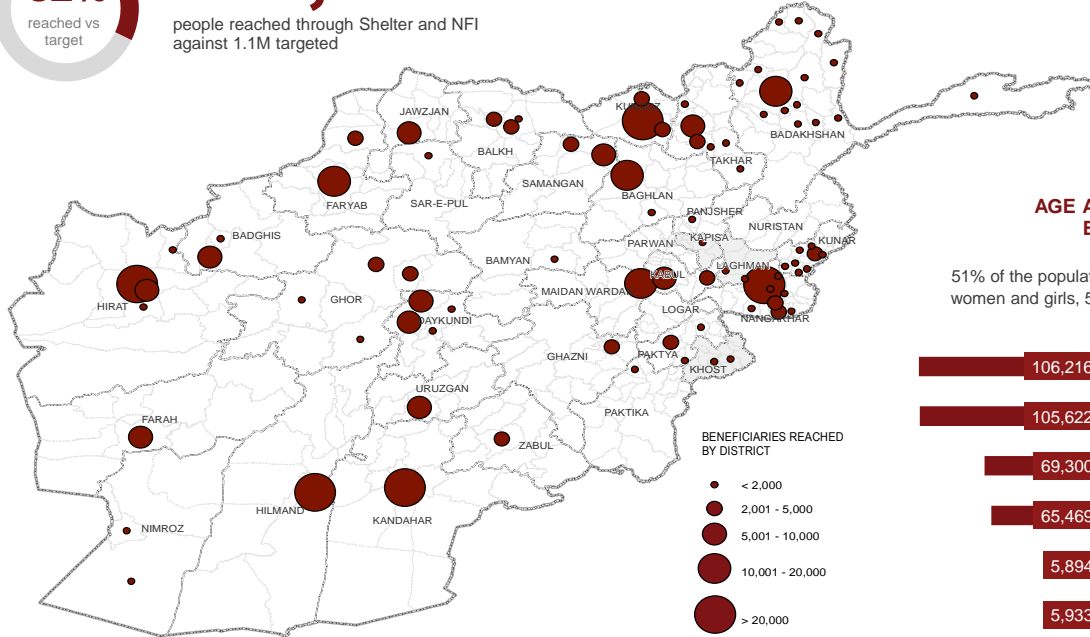




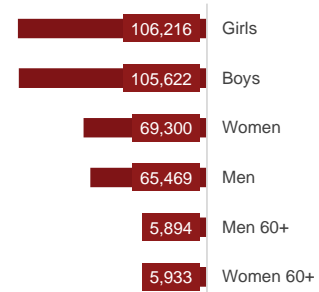

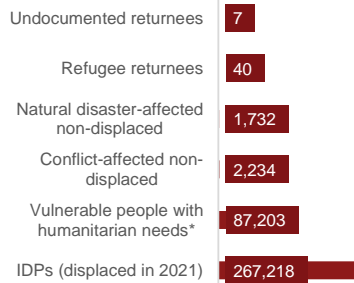


### AGE AND GENDER BREAKDOWN

51% of the population reached are women and girls, 59% are children

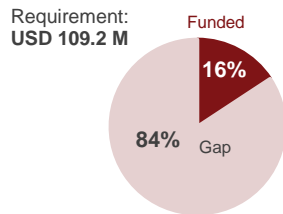


### BENEFICIARY TYPE
