


### **KEY FIGURES**

In addition to the population above, there are some 20,579 Buru es and asylum seekers in Kenya, 8,948 in Mozambique, 11,241 in Malawi, 9,870 in South Africa and 7,086 in who are assisted within the respective country-level programmes. A further 42,200 Buru who have lived for decades in Tanzania, no longer receive assistance and are not included in these figures




