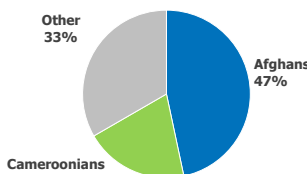

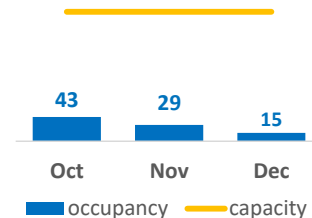
**Current age and gender breakdown**

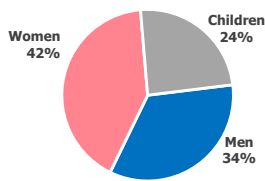

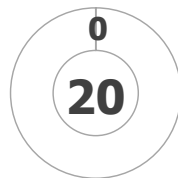

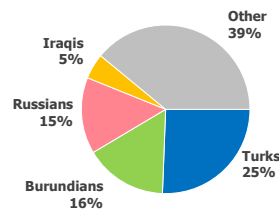

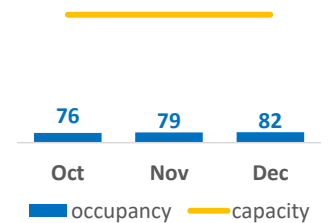
Current age and gender breakdown

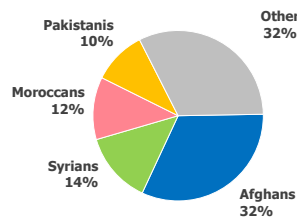

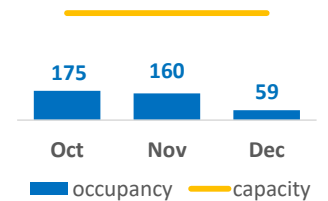
Current age and gender breakdown

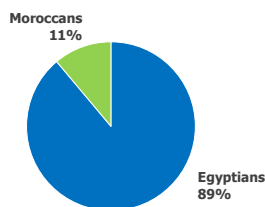

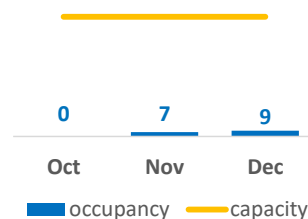
